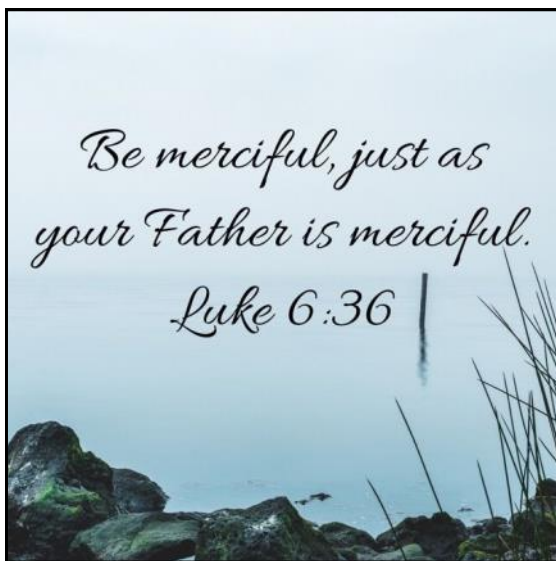

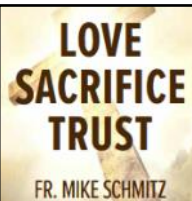

A Note From the Pastor

Dear St. Malachy Parishioners

Follow Jesus... with the Faith of a Child! As I mentioned in both last weekend's bulletin letter and a recent Thursday Thoughts, we are blessed to now have Bishop Lou's episcopal motto as a kind of "banner" over our diocese: *Go Make Disciples*. This week, I want to share about three initiatives to help disciples come together and grow in their faith:

- As we recently started advertising in the bulletin and after Mass, we are currently prepping for our next parish-wide Bible Study for adults: ***Into His Likeness*** with Dr. Edward Sri. The beginning of this study coincides with the beginning of Lent. But, like last time, we are trying to offer different smaller groups, rather than one big class. So, the specific start dates vary, and you should see the ad in this bulletin. In fact, I encourage even more small groups to join in the journey. So, if you and/or friends of yours are interested in hosting a group in your home or other location, let us know, as I'd love to help you get started. This is another study that is found on Formed.org, making it very accessible for anyone wanting to participate, lead a group or even do it on your own time! If you desire to know and follow Christ more fully, know that God is the One who has put those yearnings in your soul. He has already given you the heart of a disciple!

- Next, I made a very special announcement at the February Children's Mass last weekend: **Totus Tuus will be coming to Saint Malachy Parish this summer!** This excellent weeklong summer program provides children grades 1-12 a prayer-filled environment that will help them come closer to Christ through His Mother, Mary, inspired by the motto of St. John Paul II (Totus Tuus, Maria ~ Totally Yours, Mary). This is accomplished through games, skits, songs, lessons, daily children's Masses, more prayer,

and plenty of other exciting activities, all led by a team of four young adult missionaries who have committed their summer and been trained to go around from parish to parish, bringing this excellent program to renew parishes. They will stay in Geneseo for the week, speak to the parish at Sunday Masses, then begin offering a day-program for Grades 1-6, take a breather, then offer an evening program for Grades 7-12. So, Totus Tuus really is a moment of renewal for the whole parish! All are encouraged to support it in any way you can, even by your prayer, but especially families with children in those grades.

July 24-29, 2022.

- Lastly, I am also very happy to share that Oasis will again be sponsoring a trip to a **Steubenville Youth Conference** this summer. This is an awesome experience for high school students to have a powerful encounter with the love of Jesus Christ in a life-changing way. Personally, I have been to a number of these conferences in the past and have personally witnessed the impact they can have on the lives of young people. Saint Malachy parishioners have been blessed to have these experiences for many years, although the pandemic has prevented us from going these past two years. It will be a great gift to be able to resurrect this tradition. **July 15-17, 2022.**

More information about these opportunities can be found throughout this and upcoming bulletins, but I want to personally encourage them, as they are great opportunities to encounter Jesus Christ in the heart of His Church and either begin or deepen one's own walk with Him!

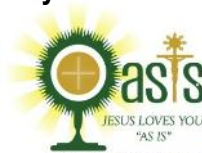

Did you Know?

Your child can attend a Catholic School Financial Assistance Available

Tuition assistance scholarship grants from the endowment fund established as a result of the Diocese of Peoria ROOTED IN FAITH Campaign and named in honor of Archbishop Spalding, the first Bishop of Peoria, will be available for the 2022-2023 school year for students enrolled in or intending to enroll in grades Kindergarten through 12 in any Catholic school located in the Diocese of Peoria whose families are active members of a Catholic parish in the diocese. All grants will be based on financial need objectively assessed.

Information about the grants and application materials may be obtained from any Catholic elementary or secondary school in the Diocese of Peoria or on the Diocesan website www.cdop.org under Catholic Education and then under Financial Assistance. Consult the detailed protocols and procedures and checklist for all requirements necessary to be eligible for an award.

Parents must apply online at: online.factsmgmt.com/aid. Families of students currently receiving grants are reminded that all grants are for one year only, and anyone seeking to renew a grant for the 2022-2023 school year must reapply.

Deadline date for the completed application is April 29, 2022. Notification of grant awards will be made by the end of June 2022.

Another funding opportunity is also available due to the Invest in Kids Act legislation in Illinois. Students may be eligible for up to 100% of tuition and fees under a new program for tax credit scholarships (TCS). Details on how to apply and who qualifies are available on the Empower Illinois website at www.empowerillinois.org. Students who receive a TCS are ineligible to receive a Spalding award.
