A Note From the Pastor

Dear St. Malachy Parishioners

Last week, I did not write to you all in the bulletin. Instead, I invited our school principal (Tim Smith) to share a year-in-review message with you all. Occasionally, I will offer my weekly bulletin column to someone who has other important information to share with you. This was the best place to start, especially since school had just ended for the year. Saint Malachy School is a very important part of the mission of our parish and I know that many of our parishioners have contributed a great deal in support of its important work and are deeply invested in its continued success and development. We don't take that for granted and want to continue to treat this very important part of our parish mission as a high priority for us all!

This week, we come to the grand conclusion of the Easter Season, as we celebrate the Feast of Pentecost, on which the Holy Spirit descended and brought the Church to life. For this reason, it is often referred to as the birthday of the Church. It is a day of great celebration. With Pentecost behind us, we will return to Ordinary Time this coming week, with our ordinary days made new by the Resurrection! For this reason, perhaps it is fitting that the celebrations are still just beginning. Next weekend, we will celebrate Holy Trinity Sunday, in which the 10:30 Mass will be our Children's Mass for the month of June. In July, there will not be a Children's Mass on Sunday, as I will be traveling on the second Sunday, as will many people. However, we will make up for it, since Totus Tuus (July 25-29) will feature five straight

days of Children's Masses (Monday-Friday)!

Finally, after Trinity Sunday comes Corpus Christi (June 18-19)! As I have already mentioned numerous times, this great Holy Day is especially important this year, as it kicks off the three year National Eucharistic Revival. At this time, let me share a bit more detail about the plan for that weekend. The 5 PM Mass on Saturday will be an **Explanatory Mass**, which means that explanations will be given at various points during the Mass, explaining what we are actually doing and why. This process will even begin about five minutes before Mass, with an explanation of the vestments. Additionally, we will have a **Commissioning of all Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion (EMHC)** after the homily and a **Father's Day Blessing** at the end. Next, the 8:15 Mass will conclude with a **Eucharistic Procession**, in which all present will be invited and encouraged to follow Jesus out into the streets (ok, technically just the sidewalk along one street) and then, we will end with benediction back in the church. The 10:30 Mass will be the simplest Mass of the weekend, however both Sunday Masses will also include the EMHC commissioning and Father's Day blessing. This very special weekend will be a great way to begin to enter more deeply into the way of life of a disciple of Jesus Christ: a life lived in God's presence!

Pentecost– June 4-5, celebrates the Holy Spirit, the gifts of **Wisdom, Understanding, Council, Fortitude, Knowledge, Piety, Fear of the Lord** and the presence of the Holy Spirit in each of us personally and communally. We are reminded that Jesus leaves us his peace as sent by the Father and that we are meant to share this as we “renew the face of the earth”.

13th Sunday in Ordinary Time - June 25-26. Pope Francis urges us to promote a healthier life for the entire human family, and for the earth, which is our common home to all.

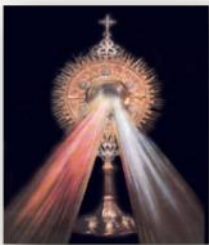

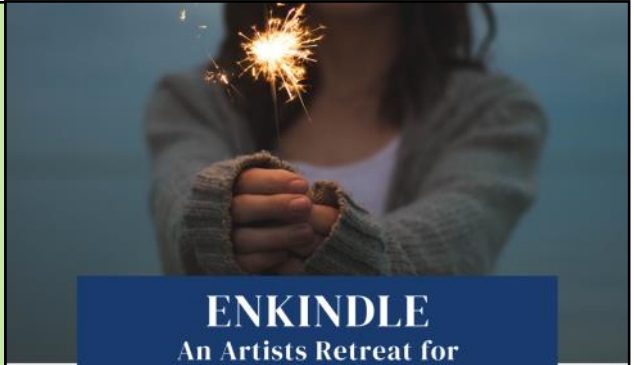
