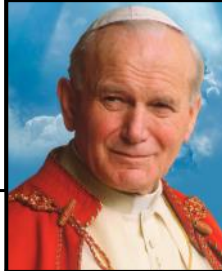

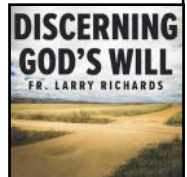

## *A Note From the Pastor*

Dear St. Malachy Parishioners

“Why does everybody scratch their nose at the same time at your church?” A visitor asked his Catholic friend, after joining him for Mass one Sunday.

“What do you mean?”

“Haven’t you noticed? Just before that last Bible reading. I think it was the one about Jesus.”

“Everybody? Really?”

“Well maybe *not everyone* does it... but at least enough people that there had to be some kind of memo that maybe some people just missed!” The inquisitive guest persisted.

“Hmmm.... I guess some of us should check our email. I think I missed that memo...” The pensive friend was basically stalling at this point, uncertain how to answer his friend’s question and starting to wonder if he too had missed something.

“Well, then you check and get back to me.”

Later that week, after checking his email, the Catholic friend could not find any memo he had missed about everyone scratching their nose at the same time. Still stumped, he got in his car and drove to the church. Upon walking into the vestibule, he spotted his parish priest walking from the church to the parish hall. “Father!” He called out, excitedly. “I’m really glad to see you. Are you busy?”

“I was just headed over for youth ministry, after finishing up Evening Prayer. But, I have a moment. What can I do for you?”

“Well this past Sunday a friend from work came with me to Mass and had an interesting question.” Father stopped him right there to thank and encourage him for bringing a friend to Mass, but he was rather impatient to get to the point and barely noticed. “He wanted to know why everyone scratched their noses at the same time.” Seeing that Father looked as puzzled as he was, he continued, “He said it was right before the Gospel. Well, he didn’t know the word Gospel, but I’m a good Catholic who had all my religion classes, so I knew what he meant. But anyway, I guess I’m here to make sure the parish office has my current email address, so I don’t miss any more memos. But, since I already missed one, was there anything else in the one about scratching our noses before the Gospel?” At this point, the very helpful friend and remarkably good Catholic noticed his priest no longer looked confused, but now seemed to be suppressing laughter. “Is something funny, Father?”

“Well, actually, yes.” Next, Father scratched his forehead, followed by his nose, and then his chest... or wait, was it his lips that he scratched? Who has itchy lips?! “Is it possible that is what your friend saw and was asking about?”

After thinking for a moment, the good Catholic answered, “Yeah, maybe that was it.”

“That is the prayer we pray before hearing the Gospel proclaimed, asking that the Gospel would be always on our minds,” again, Father scratched his forehead, “and on our lips,” and his lips, yes definitely his lips! “And in our hearts.” As he finished, he again scratched his chest. “But, as Catholics, we pray with our bodies, as well as with our souls, so as we pray this prayer silently, we make a small sign of the cross on our foreheads, on our lips and over our hearts.”

After an awkward silence, the child of God tried to save face. “Oh yeah, I knew that, but I forgot. Or maybe I was out of town for that class.”

With a warm smile, Father reassured him, “Don’t worry. It’s good to still be learning... *or remembering*. And these kinds of questions are good. Your friend did you a favor by asking. Sometimes a fresh set of eyes can help us see things we either never noticed or took for granted. There is so much in the Mass that just keeps drawing us deeper into the mystery. God is that way. He’s always drawing us deeper.” Father placed a hand on the shoulder of his brother, as

he finished, "Even us cradle Catholics." Father began to walk into the parish hall and then stopped and turned around. "Oh and one more thing."

"What's that, Father?"

"Keep inviting friends to Mass."



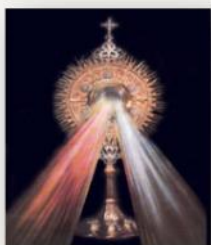
