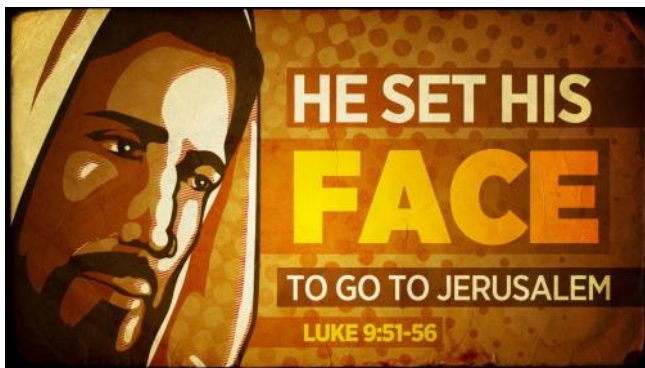

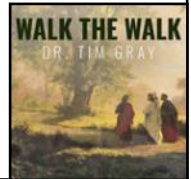

A Note From the Pastor

Dear St. Malachy Parishioners,

This prayer will accompany us through this Eucharistic Revival, which begins this weekend. As you may know by now, the weekend begins a three year long National Eucharistic Revival, initiated by our bishops. Our parish participation in this revival will be guided by the three basic elements in the central lines of the prayer. These three qualities (PRESENT, KNOWN, LOVED) will comprise a kind of road map for us: Jesus makes Himself Present (Year One); We must make Him Known (Year Two); That He may be Loved (Year Three). Thus, as I have already alluded to, this year our theme and focus will be on entering into and remaining in the Presence of God.


We will have an entire year to focus one diving into this mystery. Perhaps the first layer of the mystery to begin to wrap our heads and hearts around is that we are in the presence of God the Father when we are in the presence of His Son, Jesus Christ. As He told the Apostle, Saint Philip: "I am in the Father and the Father is in Me" (John 14:6-14). Jesus and His Father are always present to each other. It should bring us even greater comfort, then, to know that Jesus has made Himself present to us. This is true in more ways than one, to be sure. He has told us that wherever two or three are gathered in His Name, there He is in the midst of them (Matthew 18:20). Similarly, in teaching us about prayer, He spoke as if we can go before the Father in secret in the inner room of our private prayer (Matthew 6).

These two facts alone should prompt us to seek out the Lord's presence in our personal prayer and in the communal life of the Church. Yet, the witness of the earliest Christians shows that they did not devote themselves *only* to "the communal life" and "the prayers." Act 2:42 tells us that "they devoted themselves to the teaching of the apostles, to the communal life, *to the breaking of the bread*, and to the prayers." Furthermore, when we consult the "teaching

of the apostles" (I might recommend especially *Presence* and *Lectio: Eucharist*, both on FORMED.org), we see how these curious words, "the breaking of the bread," point us toward the way that Jesus Christ makes Himself present to us in every age, in a manner unlike anywhere else. Not unlike the disciples on the road to Emmaus (Luke 24) recognized Him "in the breaking of the bread," so also disciples of Christ in every age have looked to the Holy Eucharist and recognized that, while the bodily eyes see only a wafer of unleavened bread, the eyes of faith see the Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity of Jesus Christ. No wonder Christians devoted themselves to this gift!

When we allow this encounter with Christ in the Eucharist to become truly the source, summit and center of our lives, we begin to know and live what it means to live in God's presence! The Father desires that His children would live in His presence. And so, He sent us His Son, not only to be present to a select group of people who lived near Galilee and Jerusalem during a thirty three year period, 2000 years ago, but also to be present to us in every generation, through the Holy Eucharist!

Finally, when I think of this desire of the Father, that His children would live in His presence, it reminds me of how this goodness and love is reflected in the hearts of so many fathers, who desire nothing more for Father's Day than to be with their children! Remember to honor the father-figures in your life, who offer you these kinds of glimpses of the heart of the Father. And let me wish a very Happy Father's Day to all of the dads in our parish. May each of you be renewed in the joy that comes from your vocation to be a living image of the heart of God the Father *as we all enter more deeply into the way of life of a disciple of Jesus Christ: a life lived in God's presence!*
