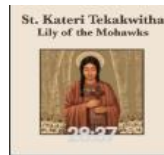

OASIS UPDATE

After our trip to the Steubenville Youth Conference, Oasis High School Youth Ministry will have a transition in leadership. Darci Harrison has discerned that the Lord is calling her to step away, in order to focus on remaining active at St. Jean Vianney in Bettendorf with her husband. We are very grateful for all of her hard work in restarting Oasis after and amidst the pandemic and for helping the program to move forward and develop. Her witness of faith, sincerity and enthusiasm has helped our young people to grow as disciples of Jesus Christ in the heart of His Church. Even this departure provides our youth with an important witness to the importance of discerning God's will and of prioritizing one's primary vocation. In the interim, Bob Thoene has agreed to return to the role of leading Oasis, in order to keep things active and vibrant, while we search for a new person to lead our youth in the long-term. Please keep this search in your prayers, as we continue to pray for all of our high school youth and all who lead them, that they might accept the invitation to follow Jesus, seek to live in His presence and discover His glorious plan for their lives.

A Note from Deacon Robert O'Rourke

This weekend, I would like to report to you some of the projects and activities that the staff and volunteers are doing and planning for the Parish this summer and fall.

Stained Glass Windows: A committee made up of Fr. Gifford, myself, the donor, and 4 parishioners have started the planning process to install new stained glass windows. The stained glass will be framed and set in front of the existing glass windows. The windows that will receive the stained glass are on the Southwest wall of the church (please see the attached photo below). We are still in the ideas and design phase of the project, and have met with three companies to help with the process. This fall we plan to choose the design and the company to install the glass. The purpose for stained glass windows is to better control the lighting, in order to enrich people's experience of our worship, as well as to be transformative, help us to contemplate our faith, and apply what we see to our everyday life. There could be opportunities in the future to treat other windows in our church if donations become available.

The Rectory: The St. Malachy Rectory will be updated with new carpet, kitchen flooring, lighting, painting, a new master bathroom and a few other adjustments. The work will begin this fall.

Deep cleaning: The school, kitchen, restrooms, Narthex, and church are being deep cleaned this summer by the maintenance staff and some summer help. Closets and file cabinets are being sorted and reorganized with the opportunity to dispose of some of the materials we no longer need. We have purchased a

commercial vacuum to improve the cleaning of our large carpet space, some 15,000 sq. ft. It's much faster and so quiet, it's amazing!

Sound System: The structure and materials used to build our church offers a challenge to find a sound system that can reach the people in the pews and the sanctuary. We will be enlisting some professional sound system companies to help us evaluate our current system, in order to seriously consider what improvements can be made, with the latest technology, to enhance our worship.

Directory: Beginning in August, St. Malachy Parishioners will be able to have their family and individual pictures taken for a new directory. Sign up dates are available after Masses, on line, and at the office. This a great opportunity for families to be a part of sharing a presentation of our parish community with one another and future parishioners. No requirement of purchase is necessary, in order to have your picture taken, so that you and/or your family can be a part of the directory.

As you can see, we have a variety of significant projects either already underway or on the horizon. For this reason, particularly with costs being higher than usual for the time being, now would be an excellent time to consider making a donation to the Capital Improvements Fund. It is these donations that make this kind of work possible and it is this kind of work that makes possible all of the work we do, to invite people into an encounter with Jesus Christ, to give witness to Him in the world, to worship together and to make disciples.

Welcome Father Narcisse to Saint Malachy Parish!

Father Narcisse SEKA Ogou hails from Côte d'Ivoire (Ivory Coast) in West Africa.

After discernment, he was admitted to start his missionary formation in 1995 with the Society of African Missions known as the SMA Fathers. Ordained on June 28, 2003 Father Narcisse's missionary experience includes ten years of Parish work in Nigeria where he was appointed right after his mission until 2013. He first worked in Northern Nigeria in the Bauchi Diocese where he pastored various rural parish missions. From the diocese of Bauchi, Fr. Narcisse was sent to Abuja, the capital city of Nigeria to be pastor in an urban parish.

His missionary experience in Abuja prepared him to work in SMA administration. So from 2013 to 2016 Fr. Narcisse was elected vice superior of the SMA Fathers in West Africa. Then SMA superior in Côte d'Ivoire from 2016 till present.

In the priestly ministry, Fr. Narcisse learned that God gives strength to people for the work he entrusts to them and that God looks beyond our weaknesses to make use of our strength. He equally learned that the best way to have fulfilment in the ministry is to be open to God's own project rather than personal ones.

Thanking Fr. Gifford for welcoming the SMA in his parish, Fr. Narcisse is looking forward to meeting the people of the parish and making new friends.

Fr. Narcisse will be with us through July 19.
