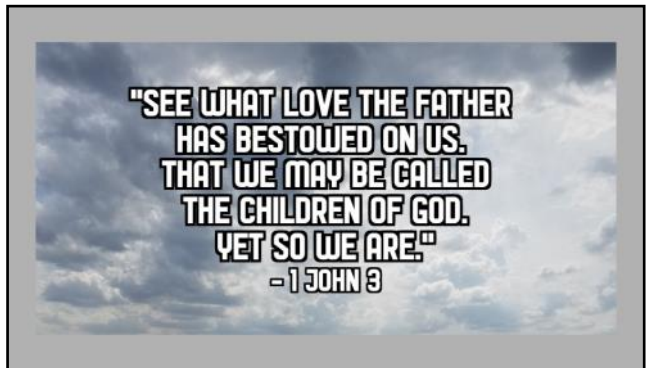

A Note From the Pastor

Dear St. Malachy Parishioners,

What a summer we have had to embrace the Presence of God! At the beginning of summer (around mid-May), I wrote a bulletin letter looking forward toward some of the landmark moments for the summer. **Next Saturday (August 13)**, we will have the last of the items on that list: **SummerFest**. After beginning the Eucharistic Revival, celebrating the anniversary of the dedication of our church building, hosting a missionary priest (Fr. Narcisse), the Steubenville Youth Conference, and Totus Tuus, we now are getting ready for a grand finale to this blessed summer! We hope you can join us for the fun.

By this time, we will be looking forward to beginning a new academic year, as we continue to dive into this first year of the Eucharistic Revival, which is focused on living in the Presence of God, especially by keeping the Sunday Mass the Source, Summit and Center of our lives. This is how a disciple lives: living from the Source, striving for the Summit, Christ as our Center. I look forward to exploring this theme more deeply with you all in the weeks and months ahead.

Especially with the beginning of this Eucharistic Revival, now is a perfect time to embrace as a kind of new beginning to our parish life. With that thought, I am very excited about a few different things in the works:


- **Activities Fair (August 27-28):** After all of the Masses in this last weekend of August, we will be holding an activities fair, for all parishioners new and old to *Come and See*. The hall and narthex will be open, with refreshments, for all to come and learn more about the wide variety of ways that one can get more involved, to enter into community, to journey together with others, to pray, grow and serve together.
- **Parish Directory:** Earlier this week, we began the first round of family pictures for our next parish directory. This is another aspect of our new beginning. Thanks to all who have already signed up. I would encourage all of our parishioners to consider

signing up for the upcoming photo sessions, as well as inviting one another to consider participating. Especially for those who have not yet reconnected with the parish, this is a wonderful and yet simple opportunity to reach out and welcome people home, as members of the family.

- **Monthly Coffee and Donuts (Third Sunday):** What a great and simple way to enjoy fellowship together: stay for coffee and donuts. We have done this sporadically in the past year, but I am very excited that beginning September 18, we will have Coffee and Donuts on the Third Sunday of every month. Different groups will continue to take turns hosting, while the overall effort will be coordinated by Parish Council.
- **Other Socials:** Additionally, stay tuned for upcoming announcements about other social events for the coming year. Another monthly opportunity will be “Stay and Play” in which families with children will be encouraged to “stay and play” after the 10:30 Children’s Mass on the Second Sunday of the month, also beginning in September.
- **Many Groups Restarting:** As we look forward to the return for a new year at Saint Malachy School, we also look forward to the return of CCD, Confirmation Prep, Youth Ministry, RCIA and Adult Studies (Discipleship Groups). We also have upcoming events being planned by both Altar and Rosary and Women at the Well. And still more to come. Keep your eye on the bulletin and if you’re not receiving the Weekly Update email, check with the parish office.

Last year, we had an excellent year to focus on the basic element that makes someone a disciple, namely the choice to Follow Jesus with the Faith of a Child. Now, I am excited to take this to the next level, by *entering more deeply into the way of life of a disciple of Jesus Christ: a life lived in God’s presence!*

August Liturgy Leanings

8/4 St John Vianney - patron of parish priests and known as the Cure' of Ars. Though not educated he was very intelligent and well versed in the faith. He rose to great sanctity, converted thousands of souls to Christ, became famous throughout the Catholic world. You might be familiar with the booklet, "Thoughts of the Cure' D'Ars". A Cure' quote "Life is given us that we may learn to die well, and ...to die well we must live well."

8/6 Transfiguration of the Lord when Jesus is changed in the presence of Peter, James, and John which highlights his divinity and glory. We may not have sat with Jesus on a mountain but if we are paying attention, we experience the transfiguration, the transformation of Christ in those around us - our "mountain moments!"

8/15 Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary is the first and best example of the glory of resurrection for human beings. Mary dies but she is taken into heaven that we might all know what awaits us after this life.

8/22 The Queenship of the Blessed Virgin Mary. The Blessed Mother has a special role on earth, and she has a special place in heaven. She is the Mother of God and Queen of Heaven

8/29 The Passion of St. John the Baptist. John pointed the way to Jesus, even when he knew it put his life in danger. Although we usually do not see persecution in the West, many Christians in other places regularly face terrible penalties for their beliefs. We must pray for those who face persecutions for their faith.

GRACE is when God gives us good things that we don't deserve.

MERCY is when He spares us from bad things we deserve.

BLESSINGS are when He is generous with both.

Truly we can never run out of reasons to thank Him.
