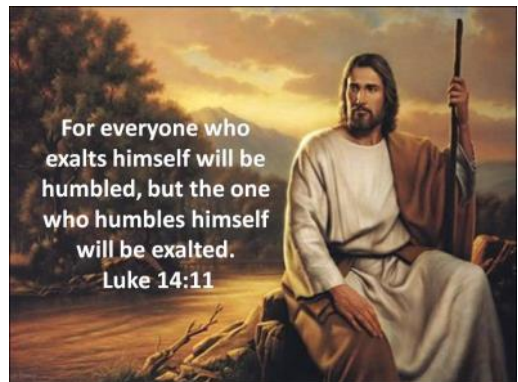

A Note From the Pastor

Dear St. Malachy Parishioners,

“What are you looking for?”

These first recorded words of Our Lord to His future disciples (John 1:38ff) are spoken to our hearts now. What are you looking for? Consider that for a moment. How would you answer the question? What are you looking for? Peace? Hope? Truth? Love? Meaning? Community? Understanding? Belonging? Happiness?

“What are you looking for?” Jesus spoke these words to Andrew and another (unnamed) of the disciples of John the Baptist, because He recognized that they had begun following after Him, after they heard their master point at Jesus and say “Behold the Lamb of God.” Their answer was striking “Rabbi” (meaning Teacher, indicating already a part of the answer to the question, because they wanted Him to teach them, to lead them to the Truth, to deeper understanding and to guidance in how to live), “Where are you staying?” They were looking for Him. They wanted, not simply to have a one-time encounter with Him, but to stay with Him, to make their dwelling with Him, to direct their lives along His steps, to follow Him. Whatever unique and personal answers to the question they might have recognized within themselves, they understood that those personal desires were pointing to Jesus. They understood that what they were looking for was Him!

What about us? Do we recognize that the deepest desires in our hearts point to Jesus Christ? Do we recognize that Jesus Christ is the One we are looking for? All of the noble desires of the human heart, the ways we might answer the question, “what are you looking for,” point us to Jesus Christ. We will find what we are looking for in Him.

When those first disciples answered Jesus

by asking where He was staying, His response was simple, “Come and (you will) see.” They accepted this simple invitation and promptly began to share Him with others. First, Andrew introduced his own brother, Simon Peter, to Jesus. The next day, Jesus called Philip to follow Him, who promptly found Nathaniel (later known as Bartholomew) and invited him to come and meet Jesus by using the same words: “Come and see.”

Next weekend, many of our parishioners, representing various groups and opportunities within the parish, will be following this example. We will be echoing the words that Christ first speaks to His disciples: **Come and See**. At next weekend’s Activities Fair (after all the Masses), you will have the opportunity to catch a glimpse of a wide variety of ways in which you can choose to become more engaged in our parish life. When Jesus began calling His disciples, He did not simply call them to Himself in a private, isolated way. He called them together, into a community of disciples.

That is what the parish is meant to be: a community of disciples who seek the Lord together, journeying, growing and serving together. This can take many forms. But, it would defeat the purpose to try to explain them in detail here and now. In order to know what kind of forms this can take...

Come and See.

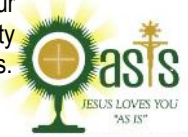
