

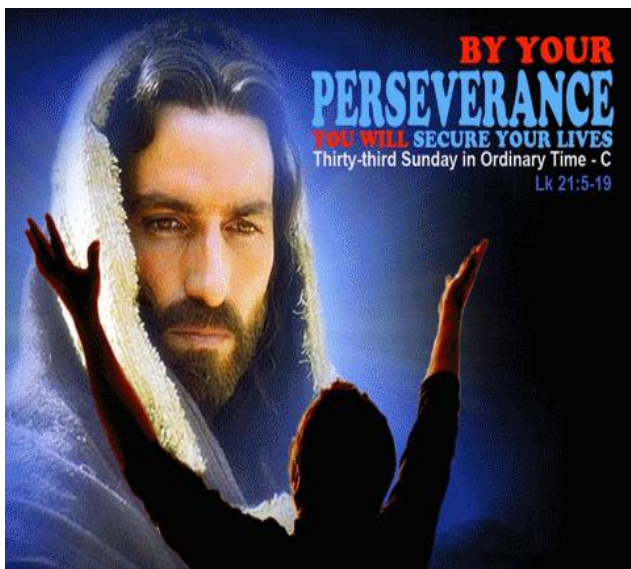

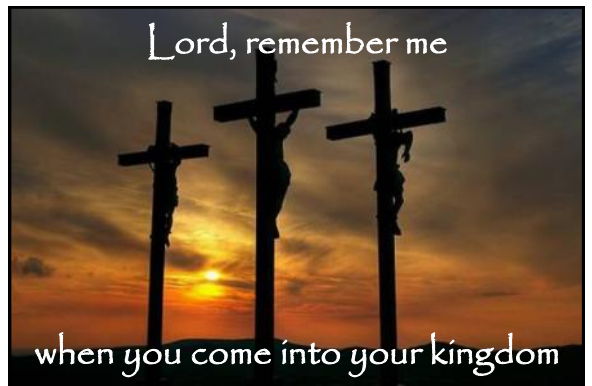

A Note From the Pastor

Dear St. Malachy Parishioners,

“Let me imitate my Master. I am a Christian to no purpose if I do not follow Christ.” With these words in a moment of profound courage, Saint Malachy reminds us that discipleship is about imitation of our Master, Jesus Christ. Having reflected on these words last weekend, as we celebrated our feast day, now let’s consider what this looks like. Imitation of Christ leads to transformation, as sinners become saints, by the grace of our loving and merciful God. But, it all begins with knowing the Lord. At some point, we meet Him and make a choice to follow Him, coming to know Him more with each and every step. It all begins with an encounter.

We encounter Jesus Christ in a deeply profound way every time that we go to Mass, attend Eucharistic Adoration or celebrate any of the Sacraments. Likewise, every time that we pray, read Sacred Scripture or serve the poorest of the poor, we have encounters with Him. Yet, often we struggle to recognize Him in these daily encounters. Often, our hearts need to be awakened to the presence of God in our lives. For this reason, a variety of movements have arisen within the Church designed to create opportunities for people to encounter Jesus Christ in a meaningful way that becomes a starting point for people to enter into a supportive community, where people strive to grow together as disciples of Jesus Christ in the heart of His Church.


For example, this very weekend, I will be dividing my time between the parish and Cursillo, where a number of our parishioners and many others from the surrounding area will be sharing such an experience. Please keep this retreat in your prayers and if you are an adult who hasn't yet experienced a Cursillo weekend, I encourage you to watch the

bulletin for the dates of upcoming weekends. Similarly, last weekend, many of the youth of our parish were joining peers from the surrounding area for the JPPII Experience weekend (for 8th-10th grades). In a few weeks, the next Teens Encounter Christ (TEC) weekend will be taking place (for ages 16+). The next TEC will be for Boys, December 3-5, 2022 and the Girls weekend will be February 11-13, 2023

Historically, our parish has had high levels of involvement in all three of these programs and I hope this trend will continue. These encounters are only meant to be beginnings. I am grateful that our parish has numerous opportunities for disciples to keep growing with the Lord and with one another, ranging from our Bible Studies for adults, to Oasis and the Rock for our youth, as well as the fraternity and support offered through groups such as the Knights of Columbus, Altar and Rosary and more.

Let us strive to know the Lord personally and help one another to walk more closely with Him, that we may grow to imitate Him and be transformed into the saints He made us to be. Abide in God's Presence: Living from the Source, Striving for the Summit, Christ as our Center. *“I have eagerly desired to eat this Passover with you before I suffer” (Luke 22:15).*

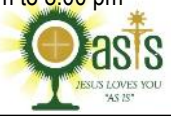

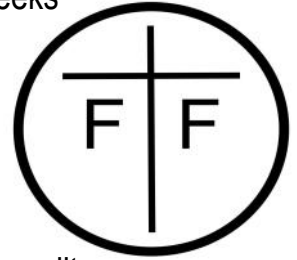
