

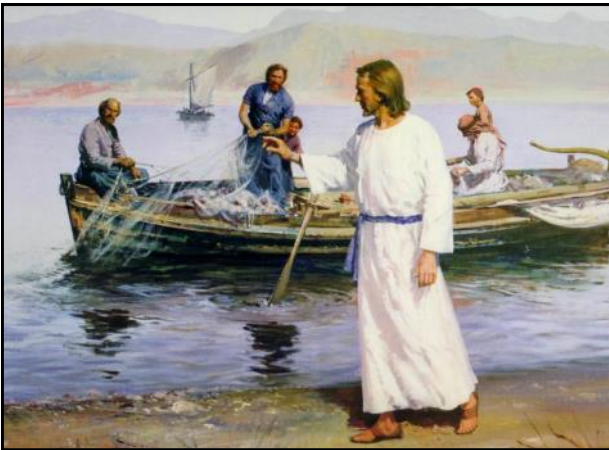

A Note From the Pastor

Dear St. Malachy Parishioners,

Almighty God, may we enter into this challenge and opportunity as a people filled with hope. Amen. We are nearing the end of our reflection on the Growing Disciples Prayer. Shortly after celebrating our Parish Feast Day, we began reflecting on the Growing Disciples Prayer in the bulletin and also began a series of Thursday Thoughts, which focused first on the Five Foundations and finally concluded this past week by talking specifically about the Growing Disciples Pastoral Planning Process, which has prompted this whole process. Last weekend, we began praying this prayer (in parts) at the conclusion of each Mass for three weeks. The Bishop has asked us to saturate this process in prayer, as it involves careful discernment and difficult decisions, which we hope to be guided by the Holy Spirit. In order to be able to keep the focus of all of our efforts on those Five Foundations (Evangelization, Eucharist, Discipleship, Vocations and the Legacy of Fulton Sheen), it is helpful to begin from a sustainable network of parishes, schools, hospitals, Newman Centers and other entities. When Bishop Lou arrived in the Diocese of Peoria (2020), he soon began traveling the diocese and learning about our parishes and other entities from clergy and laity alike. This process led very organically into the official launch of this Pastoral Planning Process in 2022.

Since then, you have been reminded of it and asked to pray for it. But, you may have wondered what is happening with this process. The phase which has just concluded has been more about us sending information to Peoria, so that they can understand the situation as clearly as possible and work toward the best possible decisions. Even

now that this first phase is complete, the process continues to rely upon a great deal of consultation and collaboration between parishes and the diocese. For example, a team of five “key parish leaders” represented our parish in a recent webinar, which answered questions and presented initial data, such as the significant decline in both Illinois population and Mass attendance, as well as the projected availability of priests in the coming years, according to the present trends of retirement, ordination and other factors. In selecting our small team, consideration was given to the need to represent a diversity of groups, such as staff, parish council, trustees, Knights of Columbus, Altar & Rosary and Finance Committee. In the end, Mary Sebastian, Julie Atwell, Kevin Lillis, Steve Mroz and Becky Werner agreed to represent us in this process. Their next task will be to review the information about our own region of the diocese, in order to ensure that the information is accurate. Later this year, the core team will present an initial draft proposal of solutions to both clergy and key parish leaders, seeking feedback. After this process of consultation, the feedback will be reviewed, in order to work toward a final set of proposals. The target date for this final set of proposals is around Pentecost 2024, beginning a process of implementation, which is expected to last into 2026. This whole timeline, as well as other information, can be found on the diocesan website (<https://cdop.org/pastoral-plan/>). Meanwhile, they also are releasing video reflections on the Five Foundations, helping us to keep this focus.

into the Word of God.



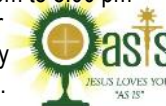

THE FIVE FOUNDATIONS

FOUNDATION 2: INSPIRE DISCIPLESHIP IN EACH BAPTIZED FOLLOWER OF JESUS



Similar to "evangelization," "discipleship" is a word we use often as Catholics. But how often do we stop to think about what discipleship really means? What did Jesus intend for discipleship when he called his first disciples?



This is precisely what **Matt Faley, Chief of Mission for the Diocese of Peoria**, and **Jenny Witt, Director of Evangelization at St. Philomena Parish**, set out to discuss in the latest video from Bishop Tylka's "Five Foundations" series. The series, available at CDOP.org/pastoral-plan/five-foundations, digs deeper into each of the five foundations upon which Growing Disciples is rooted.

In this new video, Matt and Jenny address the following and more:

- ▶ **Being a disciple of Christ requires having a relationship with the person of Jesus.** It means loving Christ, and loving one another. How do we do this?
- ▶ **In Jesus' time, he chose the "unchosen" to change the world.** This means he calls ALL of us to be his disciples, no matter where we are in our faith journeys.
- ▶ **A foundational aspect of discipleship is opening your life up to others, inviting them to encounter Christ with you.** Matt and Jenny share examples of this invitation.
- ▶ **A vibrant parish is one that offers layers of opportunities for reaching people through the head and the heart.** Matt and Jenny walk through what this looks like.
- ▶ **As disciples of Christ, we're not supposed to know it all.** We don't need to have all the answers; we are all on the way. We just need to walk together toward God's grace.



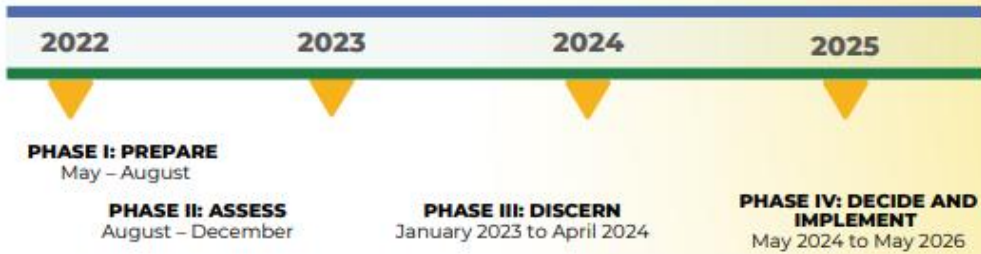
