A Note From the Pastor

Dear St. Malachy Parishioners,

HERE. *“Do not fear: I am with you; do not be anxious: I am your God. I will strengthen you, I will help you, I will uphold you with my victorious right hand”* (Isaiah 41:10). As I attempted to say clearly and even adamantly last Sunday, the point of

emphasizing the Eucharistic Presence of Jesus is not in any way to imply that He is not present to us in other ways. In fact, these words from Isaiah show us clearly how, even in the Old Covenant, the People of God had a deep awareness of the presence of God. Even in the midst of hardship and suffering, He is not far away. He is very near. And His presence makes a difference. He enables us to be free from fear and anxiety. He is our help and our strength. This confidence has brought hope, peace and strength to the People of God through the ages. And it can bring the same hope, peace and strength to your heart today.

Yet, this confidence in the Presence of God in the Old Covenant was just the beginning. The moment that the Second Person of the Trinity took on flesh and dwelt among us, the moment He became one with us... God With Us took on a whole new meaning. Humans had the chance to look upon Him with their own eyes and to marvel at the fact that He looked... just like us. With their own ears, they heard His voice once again tell us not to be anxious, as He told us in the Sermon on the Mount (Matthew 5-7): “Can any of you by worrying add a single moment to your lifespan?”

As we hear in this weekend’s Gospel, three of His closest friends were invited to follow Him up a



mountain, where their eyes saw a glimpse of glory that prompted one of them to say: *“Lord, it is good that we are here”* (Matthew 17:4). Recognizing the presence of God has a way of making us want to remain forever. When we recognize that Christ is HERE, we never want to leave HERE. The problem is that we don’t always recognize His presence in so dramatic of a fashion as those three friends were granted that day. The Mass can be that way. Our eyes look upon the Eucharist and they are not moved with the same overwhelming image of glory. Yet, do we wonder at the fact that He is HERE, just as much as He was on Mount Tabor? And that’s part of the mystery. He did not become *more* present that day. The same Jesus was with Him at the bottom of the mountain, when they were faced with the needs of the people or when they struggled to make sense of His sometimes puzzling words. In those other occasions, He simply hid His glory in humility. Likewise, in the Eucharist, He hides His glory, not just within the humility of an ordinary human appearance, but even under the appearance of ordinary bread. But, there is more to Jesus than appearances always reveal, as the Transfiguration teaches us.

Let us wonder at the mystery that Jesus is truly HERE with us in the Eucharist. May this wonder stir within us the desire to remain with Him, that we may seek to live every day in His Presence.

ALMSGIVING

Like Fasting, almsgiving is as much a spiritual discipline as an act of charity, especially when our giving comes at a personal sacrifice. In our small acts of giving we strive to imitate Christ, Who gave his life for us on the cross so that we might have eternal life. Read and discuss with your family the story of the widow's mite, (Luke 21:1-4) in which Jesus teaches us that it is the size of our generosity, not the size of our act, that matters.

Here are a few ideas for almsgiving:

- Make a Giving Jar:** Make a list of small acts of giving that your family can perform throughout the day. Later, count up their acts of kindness and deposit a coin or other token in a giving jar for every act. On Good Friday, count up the money and give it to the poor.
- Practice being present:** We can all commit to giving up our phones/electronic devices when someone is present with us. Even better create phone-free zones, (like the dinner table).

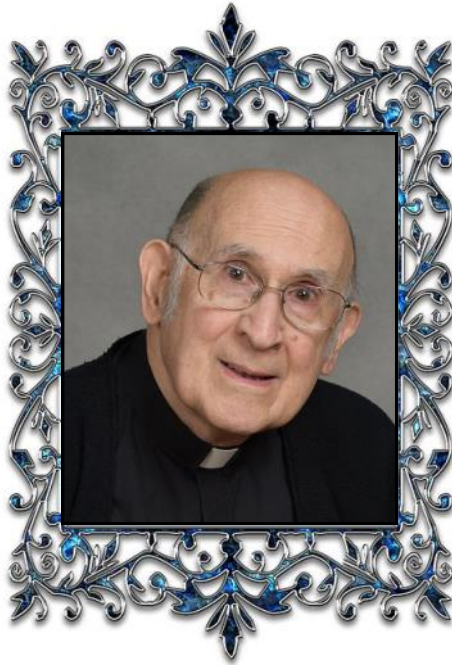

Father Michael G. Pakula, 78, of Geneseo, IL, passed away on February 21, 2023, at his home. Visitation will be held from 3-6 p.m. on Tuesday, March 7, 2023, at St. Malachy Catholic Church, Geneseo. Recitation of the Rosary by Father Daniel Gifford will follow at 6:00 p.m. A Mass of Christian Burial will be held at 10:30 a.m. on Wednesday, March 8, 2023, at the church, with Bishop Louis Tylka officiating. The service will be livestreamed on the [St. Malachy Facebook page](#). He will be laid to rest at Van Orin Repose Cemetery in La Moille, IL.
