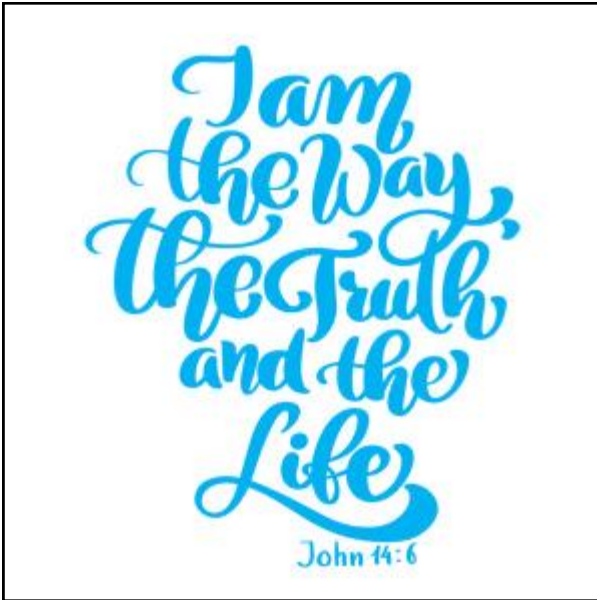

A Note From the Pastor

Dear St. Malachy Parishioners,

Welcome to the Month of Mary! It is hard to believe that it is already upon us. What an exciting month May is! The beautiful moments begin this weekend, as we celebrate First Holy Communion, with many of our children. Then, in just a few days some of our older youth will be celebrating the Sacrament of Confirmation. This is indeed a week of sacramental grace. The reason that these are such important milestones is because they are not simply rituals, but true acts of grace.

Grace is nothing less than the very life of God at work in our lives, in the lives of our children and youth in this case. God Himself comes to live within us at our baptism, when we receive the Holy Spirit. The same Holy Spirit seals us in Confirmation, in order to stir His Gifts into flame within us, so that we can be His witnesses in the world.

Finally, when we receive this gift in Holy Communion, we truly receive Jesus. Even though we receive this gift for the first time before we receive Confirmation and various other sacraments this actually is the summit of them all. This is why the receiving of the sacraments generally involves receiving Holy Communion again. The first time we receive this gift is a beautiful, special and important moment. Truly, however, every time we receive the Eucharist is equally important. Our children do us all a great service, in that all of their wonderful preparation for that first reception is a reminder to us all of the importance of every time that we receive this gift. And of course, this gift is not meant to be something we receive once, and then again only on special occasions. It is meant to be something to which we devote our lives (Acts 2:42)! It is meant to be the source, summit and center of every week.

All of this is why we have been praying the Saint Malachy Revival Prayer, after Holy Communion

throughout this first year of the Eucharistic Revival. *Lord Jesus Christ, You have made Yourself present to us in every age through the Holy Eucharist. Help us to make you more widely known that You may be greatly loved. Amen.* This prayer helps us, not only to appreciate the gift of Holy Communion more deeply, but also to answer the call of our confirmation. We are confirmed precisely in order to be His witnesses in the world: to make Him greatly known that He may be greatly loved. As we pray for our children and youth receiving these sacraments this week, let us renew our own commitment to the Holy Eucharist and to living out that call of our confirmation. When we do this, we live the mystery of the Resurrection, by allowing the Risen Christ to live within us and make His presence known in the lives of our family and friends. May He be known and loved in the hearts of all whom we love.
