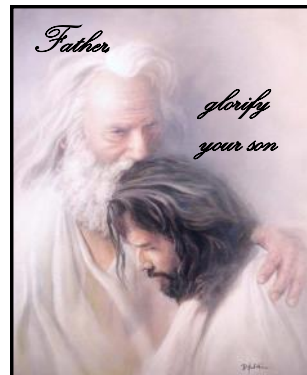

A Note From the Pastor

Dear St. Malachy Parishioners,

“Loving Mother of the Redeemer, Gate of Heaven, Star of Sea, assist your people who have fallen, yet strive to rise again. To the wonderment of nature you bore your Creator, yet remained a virgin after as before. You who received Gabriel’s joyful greeting, have pity on us poor sinners.” Among the many beautiful prayers to Our Lady, this one has long had a special place in my heart. In this Month of Mary, we ask the Mother of our Redeemer to reveal the tenderness of her Immaculate Heart, which beats, bleeds and breaks in unison with the Sacred Heart of Christ, her Son.

In addition to our Blessed Mother, this weekend we honor all of our mothers. From the May Crowning at the beginning of the 8:15 Mass to the Children’s Mass and Graduate Mass (10:30), it is an opportunity for mothers to celebrate with their children. As children of all ages, may we celebrate them! If they are living, may we thank them (and thank God for them!), honor them and respect them. If they have passed, may we remember them with grateful hearts and express our love by praying for them.

Yet, the timing of Graduate Mass falling on Mother’s Day prompts a unique thought for me. At times, I have the opportunity to discuss with adults what it means to “honor thy father and mother,” after one is no longer a child. Certainly, it is important to show them respect and love. Yet, furthermore, do we not honor our parents simply by living out our own vocations? Does it not give them honor when we strive to be the saints that God made us to be? Do we not owe them a debt of gratitude in laying a foundation for us, which enables us to make good life choices and exhibit virtues that the next generation will hopefully want to emulate? 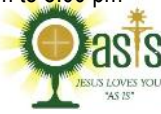

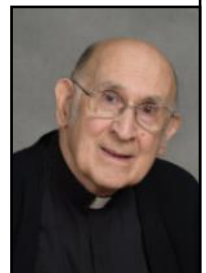
