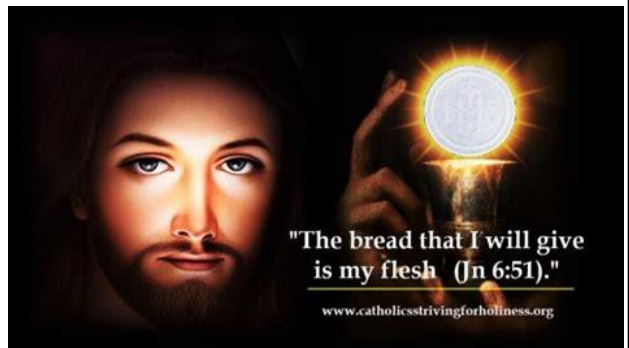

Excerpt from Bishop Tylka's Pentecost Letter

DISCIPLESHIP:

We have been chosen by Jesus and called to be his disciples. A disciple is someone who has encountered Jesus, and because of the encounter responds with the commitment to be a life-long follower of Jesus. Disciples seek to imitate the life of the master, incorporating all that they experience and learn about Jesus into their own life. As we deepen our understanding of our calling and its application across all areas of life in the Church, we seek opportunities in our parishes to provide people with the means to grow in their understanding of being a disciple and the responsibilities that flow from discipleship. Everything we do, in every aspect of diocesan life, needs to be in support of our first calling to be disciples and focused on the mission to “Go make disciples.” This entails us to be his disciple, and the development of our response to that calling. Here, I might suggest a book that I have given to our priests as a way to deepen your understanding of discipleship: *Into His Likeness* by Edward Sri.

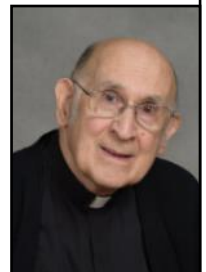
