A Note From the Pastor

Dear St. Malachy Parishioners,

“Christ, while we were still helpless, yet died at the appointed time for the ungodly... God proves his love for us in that while we were still sinners Christ died for us.” (Romans 5). These words of Saint Paul from our second reading this weekend give us a glimpse into the Heart of God. In this month of June, our hearts are called to open to the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus, as this month is dedicated to the Sacred Heart. We are invited to contemplate the love within His Heart and realize the depth of His Merciful Love. It is we who have opened that Heart with a lance. It is we who “look upon Him whom (we) have pierced,” as the Prophet Zechariah foretold (Zec 12:10) and Saint John saw fulfilled at the cross (John 19:37), when the Blood and Water flowed. Yet, the mystery of this Heart is that, when it is pierced, it loves perfectly.

When our hearts are broken, they tend to behave like any other broken thing. They tend to fail to do what they were made to do. They fail to love. Not so, the Sacred Heart of Jesus. As the opening prayer of the Divine Mercy Chaplet prays: *“You expired, Jesus, but the source of life gushed forth for souls, and the ocean of mercy opened up for the whole world. O Fount of Life, unfathomable Divine Mercy, envelop the whole world and empty Yourself out upon us.”* In this Month of the Sacred Heart, may this prayer be on our hearts, as we allow Him to teach us how to love.

Before moving on from the topic of the Sacred Heart, we should also reflect upon the ways that His Heart wishes to speak to our hearts. Consider the motto of Saint John Henry Newman: Heart Speaking

Unto Heart. One of the great ways that we can open our hearts, in order to listen and allow His Heart to speak to ours is by praying with Sacred Scripture. This weekend, we return to the Gospel of Matthew, with which many of us have already spent much time this year. If you participated in the Gospel of Matthew Challenge in February, I encourage you to revisit it. If you took notes, review those notes in your daily prayer. If you marked verses that spoke to you, return to them. One way or another, return to the Gospel of Matthew. If you didn't do the challenge, consider taking the time to read through Matthew's Gospel this summer, or at least doing your best to find some time during the week to pray with the Sunday reading. One great way to open your heart is simply by opening your Bible. Let Him speak to your heart, straight from His own.

At the beginning of this Year of Missionary Discipleship, renew your commitment to being a disciple, by taking time to quiet yourself and listen to the One whom we have chosen to follow. If you're reading this and aren't really sure if you have made a concrete decision to follow Him, consider doing that today. Now. Say a simple prayer. Jesus, help me to follow You with the whole of my life. If you're a little afraid, talk to Him about that. He is your strength. Be not afraid. Follow Him. The journey is just beginning.

Sacred Heart of Jesus, have mercy on us and grant us peace.

Fr. Pakula Memorial Food Pantry Collection

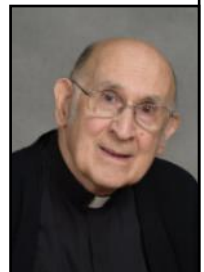
In Memory of Father Pakula, St. Malachy Parish will have a monthly theme to collect items for the Geneseo-Atkinson Food Pantry.

Excerpt from the Pentecost Letter

By Bishop Tylka

Eucharist:

We know that Jesus instituted the Eucharist as the source and summit of our Catholic lives. The Eucharist - his real presence among us - both nourishes us and sends us out to become bread for the world. It is essential for our growth as a Church that we foster a deeper understanding of the ways Christ is present to us - through the community that has gathered, in the priest who presides over the gathering, in the Word that is proclaimed, and most especially in his Sacred Body and Precious Blood. The awareness of Jesus coming to us as we celebrate the Mass and remaining with us in the adoration of the Blessed Sacrament is interiorly transforming. Coinciding with the National Eucharistic Revival, we are focusing our efforts in deepening our appreciation of the Eucharist and the ecclesial unity among those who worship. A diocesan monstrance and a diocesan chalice and paten are traveling across the diocese and are used during holy hours and Masses. We recently held a Eucharistic Revival for all of our Catholic high school students that also included the presence of relics of Blessed Carlos Acutis and Saint Manuel Gonzales Garcia. And we eagerly anticipate the National Eucharistic Congress that will be held in July of 2024 in Indianapolis.
