

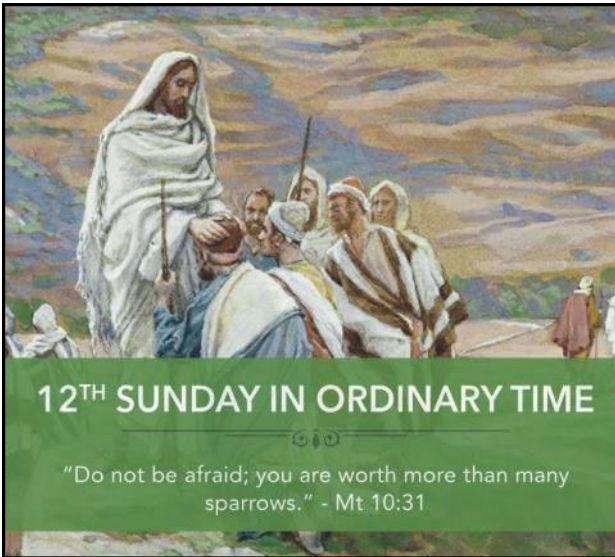

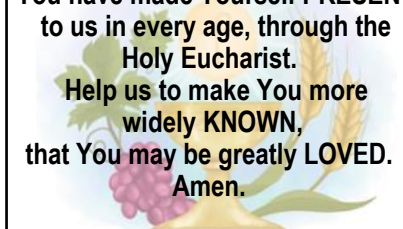

A Note From the Pastor

Dear St. Malachy Parishioners,

Friends, I would like to introduce you to Fr. Claude Nikpi of the Society of African Missions (SMA). If you recall, last summer, we had a visit from an SMA priest with us for two weeks in July. It was a blessed experience for all. With the encouragement of both Parish Council and Finance Council, I invited SMA to send a priest to be with us for the entire month of July this summer.



Fr. Claude hails from Cote d'Ivoire (Ivory Coast) in West Africa. He was ordained on July 15, 2006 (which means he will be with us for his 17th anniversary) in Ivory Coast. From 2006 to 2013, he worked in Nigeria, in West Africa. After that, he spent a few years in the United States, working in Tenafly, NJ from 2013 to

2016. Since then, he has again been serving back in Nigeria. He currently serves in the Administration of the Society of African Mission (SMA) Province of Nigeria, residing in Abuja, Nigeria. While he has had experience in the United States, this will be his first time visiting the Diocese of Peoria and he is very much looking forward to having that experience. This means we have a golden opportunity to give him an excellent first impression! I know you all will rise to the challenge! Thank you in advance for helping me make him feel welcome.

The longer stay means that he and I will be able to work together for a couple of weeks, so that I can help him get acclimated to the parish, before he takes over for me during my vacation. The second of those weeks will be Totus Tuus. Not only does this mean that I will have help from a second priest, during that very busy week, it also means that our children will have a chance to learn from him as well. Truly, we all have a great deal we can learn from him. Still early in this Year of Missionary Discipleship, it will be a blessing for us all to have a chance to get to know a missionary who can teach us a great deal about what it means to be a missionary disciple. He will also have a chance to make an appeal and give us the opportunity to support the good work of the Society of African Missions. We will have the chance to meet him in person next weekend.

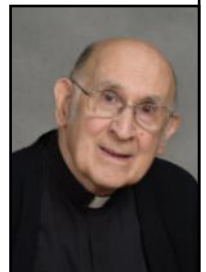

Excerpt from the Pentecost Letter

By Bishop Tylka

Vocations:

Recently, the Diocese of Peoria was recognized as one of the top dioceses for the promotion of vocations. God has blessed us with seminarians who are studying for the priesthood for our diocese and with young women who are entering consecrated life. Our responsibility as a Church is to promote and encourage everyone to discern and respond to God's call in their lives - in whatever path Our Lord has chosen for them. There is much work to do in this foundation - not only in promoting vocations to the priesthood or consecrated life, but also the vocation to holy matrimony. One recent effort was a pilgrimage to France to pray for vocations among our patron saints of vocations: St. John Vianney, St. Thérèse of Lisieux, and Sts. Zellie and Louie Martin (the parents of St. Thérèse). We continue our investment in college Newman centers and our strong support of the Vocations Office and the seminaries of Immaculate Heart of Mary, Mount Saint Mary's, and now Mundelein Seminary of the University of St. Mary of the Lake. As we look to the future, along with our efforts to promote and support priestly and religious vocations, we are continually renewing our efforts to provide marriage preparation programs that assist and support our ministry to young people and families.
