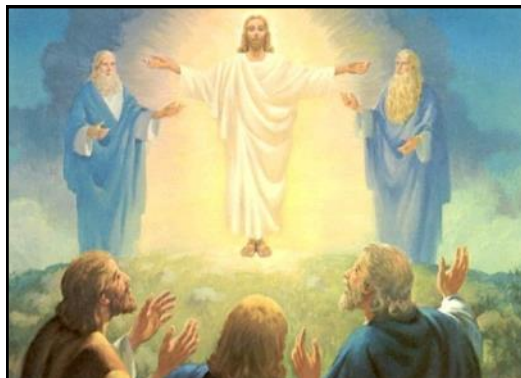

From Fr. Claude

Peace be with you beloved,

Last two weeks, I had the opportunity to visit some of our parishioners in the Assisted Living Homes and Nursing Homes. It was a moment to offer the sacrament of Reconciliation and Holy Communion for those who desired as well as pray the rosary with them. I thank and encourage those who are involved in this ministry. Visiting with the sick and home bound is always for me a journey of faith. During such visits I am challenged in the practice of my faith and encouraged to move on whatever may be my situation.

It is not strange to me and (I guess) to some of us that sometimes we question the presence of God in our life, and the relevance of our faith especially when events in our life do not unfold according to our desires and plans, when things crumble around us. We tend to despair, to quit or to look elsewhere for a way out. But here during my visits, our sisters, and brothers, through their presence at the Communion service, their smile and kind words to the ministers and to me, tell us "GOD LOVES YOU!". Besides, when I see their faces brighten up after they receive the Holy Communion, I cannot but thank God for his loving presence in their life. Truly, Jesus is present to us more than we are to ourselves; he loves us more than we love ourselves. He invites us to remain steadfast in our faith and in our commitment to God, casting all our anxieties on him, for he cares about us (cf. 1Pet 5:7). In the same vein, Joseph M. Scriven in his poem (1855) interpreted by many artists invites us thus "*Have we trials and temptations? Is there trouble anywhere? We should never be discouraged; take it to the Lord in prayer. Can we find a friend so faithful who will all our sorrows share? Jesus knows our every weakness; take it to the Lord in prayer.*" Come Lord Jesus!

WITH GRATITUDE

There is a song I learnt long ago in the Catechism class (CCD) which lyrics are: "*It is said that to go is to die a little bit; but to go in search of God is to find life*" (translation from the French version "*On dit que partir c'est mourir un peu; mais s'en aller pour trouver Dieu, c'est trouver la vie*").

It is now a month since I arrived St. Malachy parish- Geneseo; one month in search of God with each one of you and as a community of believers; one month of joyful and spirit- filled Christian and community life experience; one month of learning; one month of resting also. Today, I am preparing to head back to my assignment post in Nigeria. I am filled with mixed feelings: a feeling of sadness of leaving a lovely community; and a feeling of joy of going back to resume my missionary activities and share with my people there what I have learned from St. Malachy. As a missionary, I need to move in obedience to where the Spirit of God directs me (cf. Abraham, Jesus to his disciples in Mk 1:37-38...).

But I can't go without expressing my gratitude to our almighty Father to whom we owe everything for giving me the opportunity to be here. I thank our lovely and humble pastor Fr. Daniel Gifford for opening the doors of the rectory and of the parish to me and for making feel at home even before I arrived and more so from the very first minute, we physically met. (Fr. Gifford, you have been in a short period of time a brother and mentor to me). I thank the Deacons and the office staff for their availability to help and guide me in what I needed to do. I thank you sisters and brothers for making me be comfortable and for teaching me in your way what it entails to be human and Christian through your warmth and simplicity of your life. I am so grateful to one and to all.

My stay in St. Malachy re-energized me physically and spiritually through the various spiritual and social activities I participated in from the celebration of the Holy Eucharist, the adoration of Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament, the Totus Tuus week, communion to the sick and Homebound, to meals in various homes and restaurants, and other social activities. Summer is rightfully the time to rest, time to take kids out of the daily routine of life, to have fun and visit other family members; activities appear slow in many places including parishes. However, in St Malachy, I was confirmed in my belief that the best rest each one of us needs is to rest in God in whom "*We live and move and have our being*" (Act 17:28).

I pray that God, by the power of his Spirit, may continue to strengthen our faith, bind us together and lead us to the true Peace and Joy through Christ our Lord.

May our heavenly Mother keep us from all harm; and may St. Malachy pray for us.

You will ever remain in my prayers. Remain Blessed. Peace.

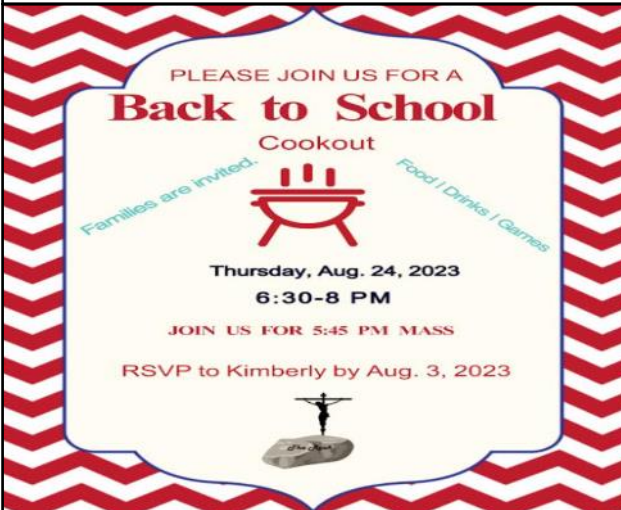
