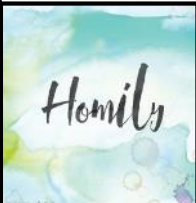

A Note From the Pastor



Dear St. Malachy Parishioners,

“They set out at once and returned to Jerusalem where they found gathered together the eleven and those with them... Then the two recounted what had taken place on the way and how he was made known to them in the breaking of the bread” (Luke 24:33,35). He makes Himself known to us. This is how it begins. This is the gift entrusted to us and it is a gift meant to be shared. This is the missionary call of discipleship. It begins with receiving from the Lord, but it leads us to share what has been given to us. This has been our focus in this new Year of Missionary Discipleship, the second year of the Eucharistic Revival. And these words from the conclusion of that Easter Story from the road to Emmaus have been our theme verse since we entered this new year, on Corpus Christi (June 11) 2023.

This focus is especially appropriate as we begin another new academic year. The life of a disciple is the life of a student. In following Christ, we sit at the Master’s feet and continue to learn from Him, as He makes Himself known to us. It is very exciting to think that we will be welcoming our students back to Saint Malachy School this Wednesday and the following week, we will be welcoming back our CCD and Confirmation Prep students. And that same week, adult disciples will begin the fall adult study, *The Great Adventure: First Corinthians*.

Currently, much of my time and energy has gone into getting ready for this “back to school” season by preparing lessons and reflections for our teachers and catechists. The focus of this first

round of lessons is the foundation that our mission flows out of identity, which flows out of relationship (Relationship, Identity, Mission). We do not arbitrarily decide on things we want to do for the Lord, but strive to live out our identity consistently as children of God and members of the Body of Christ. This identity flows out of relationship, because it is rooted in communion with God and with one another. We are not our own. We belong to the Lord and to one another. In this we find our identity. When Jesus calls us to follow Him, He is inviting us into a deeper RELATIONSHIP with Him. This relationship comes with a new IDENTITY, namely that of a disciple. This identity as a disciple comes with a MISSION, because we are called to share what we have received. Thus, this principle of Relationship, Identity, Mission can be seen as the foundation of missionary discipleship.

If we are to answer the missionary call to share what we have received, we must return to that first identity of a disciple. We must draw near to the Lord and let Him speak to our whole hearts, stirring our affections, enlightening our minds and guiding our wills. May each of us allow Him to call us nearer to Himself today. Next week, I look forward to sharing more with you about how we will “relaunch” the Year of Missionary Discipleship during “Mission Month” (September). Until then, don’t forget to join us next Saturday after Mass (which will be moved to 4 PM) for Summer Fest. And bring a friend! Thanks be to God for the many blessings He bestows upon us at Saint Malachy Church.

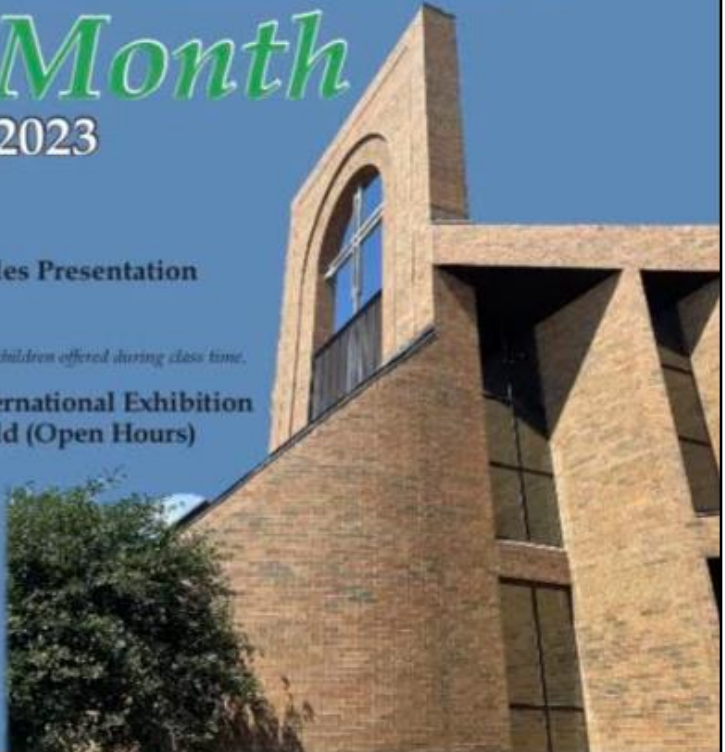

In Memory of Father Pakula, St. Malachy Parish will have a monthly theme to collect items for the Geneseo-Atkinson Food Pantry.

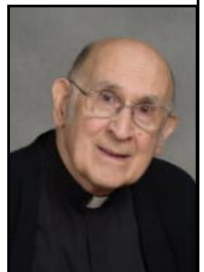
