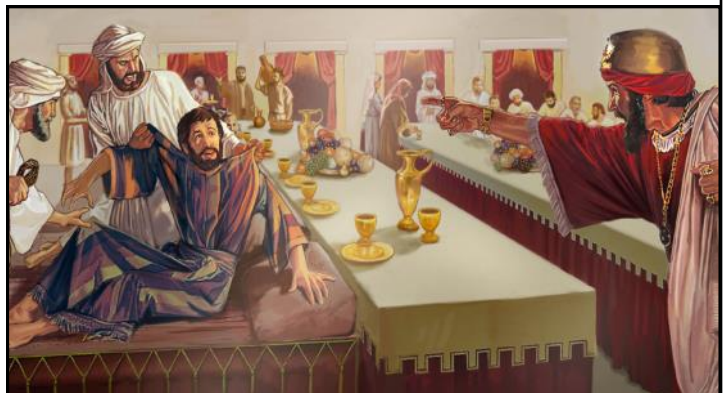

A Note From the Pastor



**EVERY HEART THIRSTS...
BECAUSE HE THIRSTS FOR
EVERY HEART
Week One: Good Wine**

Dear St. Malachy Parishioners,

“My friend had a vineyard on a fertile hillside... within it he... hewed out a wine press. Then he looked for the crop of grapes.” (Isaiah 5). Now, here is a man thirsting for good wine! Consider how Jesus fulfills this desire. At the wedding feast at Cana (John 2), we hear the proclamation: *“You have kept the good wine until now.”* Yet, this would only be the beginning. When the time of fulfillment had come, He took up a cup of wine *“gave thanks, and gave it to them, saying, “Drink from it, all of you, for this is my blood of the covenant, which will be shed on behalf of many for the forgiveness of sins”* (Matthew 26).

The good wine that our hearts are thirsting for is the gift that Our Lord gives us in the Holy Eucharist, the gift of His Blood poured out for our sins. Every human heart has this thirst for the Lord deep within. It is expressed beautifully in **Psalm 42**: ***“As the deer longs for the running waters, so my soul longs for You, my God.”***

And yet, the thirst of the vineyard owner in Isaiah's parable from this weekend's first reading is actually speaking of the Lord's own thirst for His people. This points to the mystery that the thirst in our hearts was placed there by God, as a reflection of His thirst for us. Every human heart thirsts for God, because God thirsts for the love of every human heart. This is the foundation of Respect Life Month, realizing the immeasurable love that God has for every human heart. He thirsts for our hearts!

And that is why we thirst for Him.

As I mentioned a few weeks ago, the arrangements are currently under way for **stained glass windows based on Psalm 42**. This weekend, I am sharing with you a current rendering of that design. Finishing touches are still being made to the design, but besides a few possible minor adjustments, this is what the windows will look like.

As I do so, I am also beginning a three-week series of reflections on Psalm 42 in my bulletin. This is the first. This desire for God, which *the God who desires us* has placed within us, has been expressed numerous times in Sacred Scripture as a thirst (or hunger). As a result, Psalm 42 becomes a kind of meeting point of a great many scriptural passages that speak of this same thirst and how it points us to God and to the Holy Eucharist. By the time this three week series is complete, I still will have only scratched the surface, so we will have much more to explore later, especially when the windows arrive.

I have mentioned a few of these examples already. Our thirst for the good wine that comes from the Lord is ultimately fulfilled by the Lord Himself in the Holy Eucharist. The Lord has Good Wine in store for His people and He desires to satisfy our thirst. We hear this very clearly later in the Book of the Prophet Isaiah: *“All you who are thirsty, come to the water! You who have no money, come, buy grain and eat; Come, buy grain without money, wine and milk without cost!”* As the Lord promises both grain and wine, it becomes clear the gift that He will give to satisfy our longing is the Holy Eucharist. This is why it is such a gift that these windows were envisioned and will be coming to completion within the Eucharistic Revival. You will notice that the font of the stream is not seen in the windows. This visual is meant to point our attention

toward the altar. The stream is flowing from the altar, where the Lord satisfies our longing.

May we rediscover the beauty of this gift and seek to make Him more widely known! *"They set out at once and returned to Jerusalem where they found gathered together the eleven and those with them... Then the two recounted what had taken place on the way and how He was made known to them in the breaking of the bread"* (Luke 24:33,35).

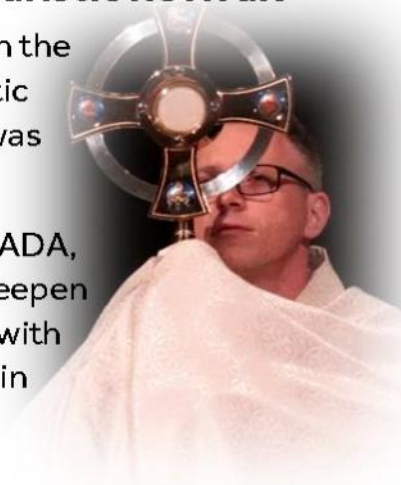
