

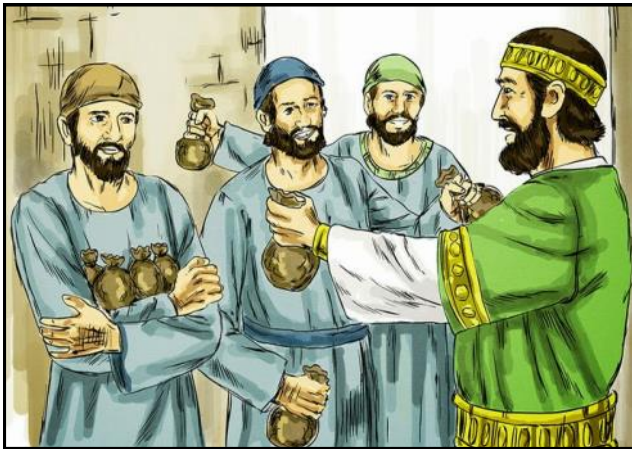

A Note From the Pastor



Dear St. Malachy Parishioners,

“Well done, my good and faithful servant. Since you were faithful in small matters, I will give you great responsibilities. Come, share your master’s joy.” (Matthew 25). Do we not long to hear these words? Do we not long to share in the master’s joy? As we sit down for a bounteous meal this week for Thanksgiving, perhaps we might imagine it to be a foretaste of that final sharing in the master’s joy, to which we look forward in heaven. And yet, this parable challenges us to recognize the way to that joy, not in the gifts bestowed upon us, but in the responsibility and generosity with which we make good use of those gifts. It is no wonder, then, that Thanksgiving becomes an important time to remember those who remain in need of the gifts that we already enjoy. This whole month, collections have been taken for the Geneseo-Atkinson Food Pantry by our families in Saint Malachy School, CCD and Confirmation Prep. This weekend and next, one percent of our parish collection also benefits the food pantry. Likewise, a collection for the pantry will be taken up at the Community Thanksgiving Worship, sponsored by the Geneseo Ministerial Association.

Thanksgiving overflows in generosity. It is an invitation to remember that all that we have is a gift and is not to be taken for granted. This is a basic fundamental principle of stewardship. We are not meant to store up possessions in this life, but to be good stewards of all that has been entrusted to us. Thus, this is a very fitting moment to recall the Saint Malachy Stewardship Prayer, which was faithfully embraced by our parishioners for many years:

Generous God, I give thanks to You for the gifts You have given me - my life, my family, my friends - time, abilities, and material possessions. All that I have comes from You. Renew in me Your Spirit. Help me hear Your call to ‘Come Follow Me.’ I give glory to You, my God, as I make stewardship a way of life. Amen.

May you all have a very blessed and Happy Thanksgiving. In this Year of Missionary Discipleship, may we be ready for the ways in which we are given opportunities to shine His Light for our friends and family, as the Lord sends us out to make Him more widely known. *“They set out at once and returned to Jerusalem where they found gathered together the eleven and those with them... Then the two recounted what had taken place on the way and how he was made known to them in the breaking of the bread”* (Luke 24:33,35).

STAINED GLASS WINDOWS: This weekend, you will see information in this bulletin (and beyond) about the opportunity you have to be a part of our stained glass window project. This project has been a very long time coming for many of our parishioners. We are excited to be moving forward with phase one, as we enhance the six large sections of window on the southwest wall, facing Ogden Avenue, with an image based on Psalm 42: *“As the deer longs for the running waters, so my soul longs for You, O God.”* Let me extend my thanks in advance to anyone who chooses to support this project. In addition to reducing the glaring sun in the eyes of our parishioners and guests, I am confident that it will also add beauty and inspiration to our worship.

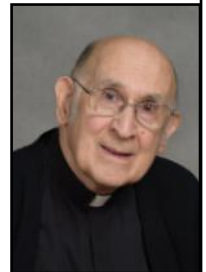

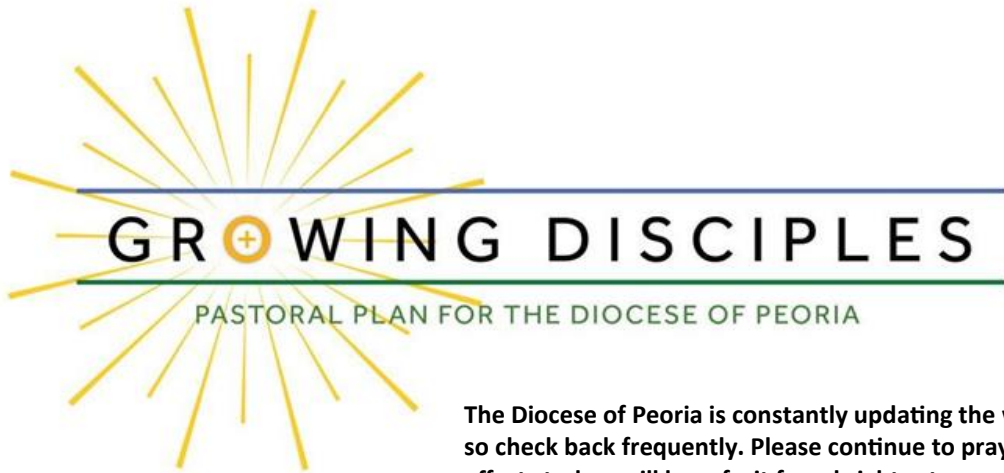
