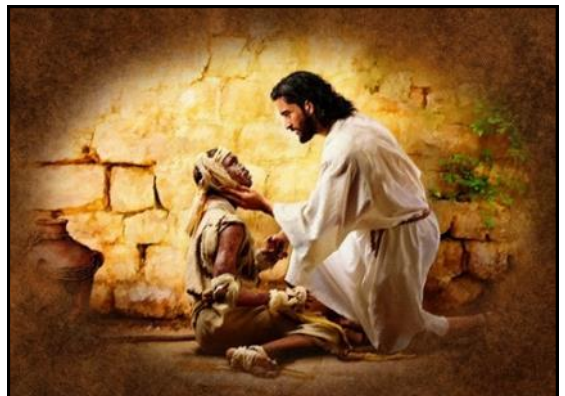

A Note From the Pastor



Dear St. Malachy Parishioners,

“Let us go on...” (Mark 1). By the time we read these words from the lips of Jesus in today’s Gospel, a lot has happened. In one day, He amazed people in the synagogue, first by teaching with authority and then demonstrating that authority by casting out an unclean spirit. When he returned to Simon’s house, he healed his mother in law and then more and more people started arriving, needing healing and deliverance. After sneaking away for some time of prayer (essential for anyone who seeks to do the Will of God), His mission is clear and His conviction is strong: *“Let us go on...”* The journey was just beginning.

As we celebrate the 100 Year Anniversary of our school this weekend, much has already happened. The Lord has made Himself known and revealed His glory to us and to our local community through us in mighty ways. We look back on this with thankful hearts. I am thankful to anyone who has been a part of this 100 year history, whether as former students, parents, teachers or longtime supporters. I want to especially thank those who have shared their “Saint Malachy Memories” in our bulletin and the committee planning our 100 Year Celebration for initiating this. Memory is such a powerful tool in keeping our gratitude deep and our hope strong.

And yet our mission is clear and our conviction is strong: *“Let us go on...”* The journey is just beginning. I am also so thankful for those who are keeping Saint Malachy School strong today: our teachers and staff, our students and parents, and all

of our supporters. Our school is a very important part of the mission of this parish, for which we pray at every Mass, making all of our parishioners a part of that bastion of support. To this day, our school remains an amazing place where minds are developed, hearts are grown, friendships are formed, memories are made and dreams are inspired.

We remain committed to the mission of making disciples of Jesus Christ in the heart of His Church. And like blood pumping throughout the body, those whose minds and hearts are forged here are sent out into our local community and beyond to bring the Light of Christ, even into the darkness. This year, our students have reminded me every Wednesday at School Mass: *This Little Light is what? Christ the Lord! And what are we gonna do with it? Let it shine!* And of course, this little slogan is a part of our Year of Missionary Discipleship, the second year of the Eucharistic Revival, in which we discover the altar as the place where we, not only meet Jesus, but also are sent out to shine His Light in the world and make Him more widely known. *“They set out at once and returned to Jerusalem where they found gathered together the eleven and those with them... Then the two recounted what had taken place on the way and how he was made known to them in the breaking of the bread”* (Luke 24:33,35).

I hope you can join us for our open houses and receptions, as we celebrate this great milestone. And again, thank you for being a part of this 100 year history. Now, let us go on...!

"Household Cleaning Products"

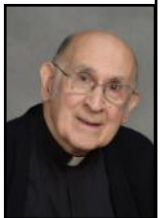

John Lancaster Spalding Scholarship Fund Grants Tuition assistance scholarship grants from the endowment fund established as a result of the Diocese of Peoria ROOTED IN FAITH Campaign and named in honor of Archbishop Spalding, the first Bishop of Peoria, will be available for the 2024-2025 school year for students enrolled in or intending to enroll in grades Kindergarten through 12 in any Catholic school located in the Diocese of Peoria whose families are active members of a Catholic parish in the diocese. All grants will be based on financial need objectively assessed.

Information about the grants and application materials may be obtained from the Diocesan website www.cdop.org under the heading Catholic Education and then under Financial Assistance. Consult the detailed protocols and procedures and checklist for all requirements necessary to be eligible for an award. Parents must apply at: <https://online.factsmgmt.com/aid>. Families of students currently receiving grants are reminded that all grants are for one year only, and anyone seeking to renew a grant for the 2024-2025 school year must reapply. Deadline date for the completed application is April 26, 2024. Notification of grant awards will be made in June of 2024.

Another funding opportunity is also available due to the Invest in Kids Act legislation in Illinois. Students may be eligible for up to 100% of tuition and fees under a new program for tax credit scholarships (TCS). Details on how to apply and who qualifies are available on the Empower Illinois website at www.empowerillinois.org. Students who receive a TCS are ineligible to receive a Spalding award.
