

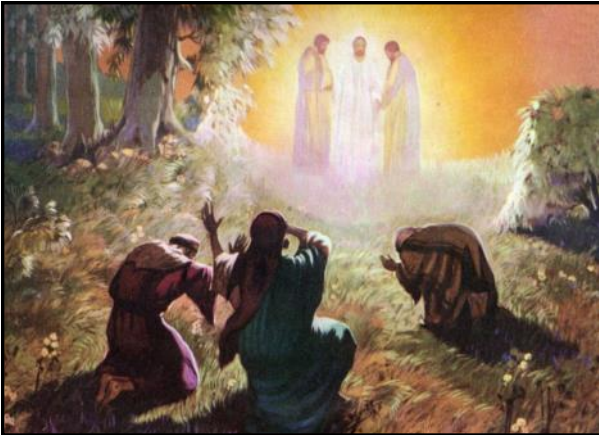

A Note From the Pastor



Dear St. Malachy Parishioners,

"Was it not necessary that the Messiah should suffer these things and enter into his glory?" (Luke 24:26). This Lenten theme verse is very thought-provoking. Have we ever found ourselves asking a similar question about our own suffering? Was it necessary that I should suffer these things? I won't claim to be able to answer that question. But, perhaps we are being invited to take a step back and consider that it was necessary for Our Lord, our Messiah, our Savior to suffer... for your salvation and mine. We don't always know why things happen the way they do in our lives, especially when suffering is involved. Still, we can remember what the Lord has done for us... what He has suffered for us... for you. This is the Good News, the very meaning of the word *Gospel*.

Often these questions about our own suffering can hold us back from turning to the Lord, remaining with Him or turning back to Him. But, in this first step of our three step journey, we have been invited to "Repent and believe in the Gospel." If your suffering is making it hard for you to repent, to turn back to the Lord, maybe start by believing in the Good News of all that the Messiah has done for us, all that He has done for you! Let us thank the Lord that He has never abandoned us, and even when we were suffering, we were not alone. He suffers with and for us, offering us salvation, hope and strength. In gratitude, let us turn back to Him with our whole hearts.

GOSPEL OF MARK CHALLENGE: Later this week (March 1), we will be starting the Gospel of Mark Challenge. By now, those on our parish email list should have received an invitation to sign-up. If you have an email address, but are not on this email list, we invite you to pass along your email address to the parish office. Regardless, you can sign up to participate either by responding to the email or by calling the parish office. Here's how the challenge works. Simply read one chapter of the Gospel of Mark each day, beginning on March 1 and ending on March 16, right before Saint Patrick's Day and Passiontide! If you get behind or miss a day, do not worry. Just pick it up the next day and keep going, without getting discouraged. Even if you finish on a later date, you will

still be a part of this community experience. You are only signing up to do your best!

Last year, we had just over 200 people participating in the Gospel of Matthew Challenge. This year, our goal will be 225 people. If we reach that goal, I will be rewarded with a whipped cream pie in the face. If we reach 300 people, two pies.

There will be four additional opportunities, which may enhance your experience if you choose to take advantage of any of them. These will be: 1) the **Kick-Off Event** at 7 PM on Wednesday, March 6, leading into ADORE, 2) **daily emails** with a word of encouragement, a verse for the day and relevant Catechism passage, 3) three weekly video episodes of **"Three Friends and a Bible"** discussing the chapters for that week, as a part of Thursday Thoughts, and 4) **discussion** with family, friends or a prayer group. If you are discussing it with a group, you may do this with your own existing group or reach out to the parish office if you do not have one. Questions you might use for discussion could include: 1) Was there a particular aspect of this week's readings that struck you? 2) Is there anything that you either learned or have begun to see in a new light, after this week's reading? 3) What has this revealed to you about the truth of who God is? 4) What are you going to do about it? Is there anything that this week's reading might be calling you to work on in the days ahead? 5) How can the group pray for you this week?

Finally, let's not forget that the purpose of this is to hear the Lord's voice, in a daily encounter with Him, through the Sacred Scriptures. So, let us not rush our reading. Pray first and read slowly. I will give more guidance about praying with Scripture in the coming weeks. I hope you can join us!

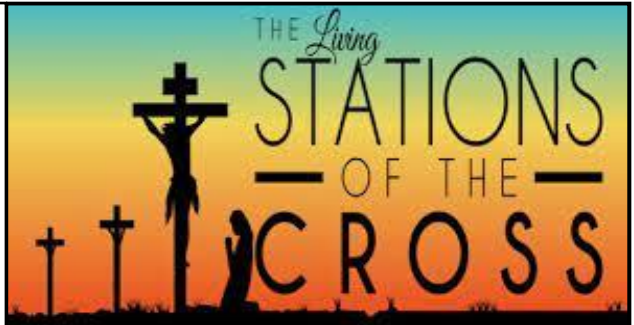

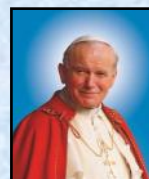

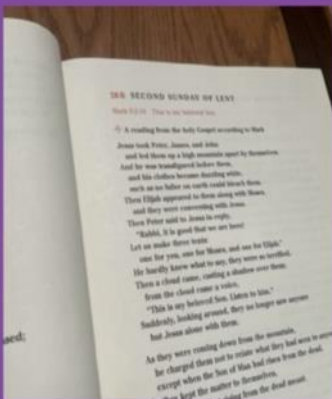

Financial Assistance Available



John Lancaster Spalding Scholarship Fund Grants Tuition assistance scholarship grants from the endowment fund established as a result of the Diocese of Peoria ROOTED IN FAITH Campaign and named in honor of Archbishop Spalding, the first Bishop of Peoria, will be available for the 2024-2025 school year for students enrolled in or intending to enroll in grades Kindergarten through 12 in any Catholic school located in the Diocese of Peoria whose families are active members of a Catholic parish in the diocese. All grants will be based on financial need objectively assessed.

Information about the grants and application materials may be obtained from the Diocesan website www.cdop.org under the heading Catholic Education and then under Financial Assistance. Consult the detailed protocols and procedures and checklist for all requirements necessary to be eligible for an award. Parents must apply at: <https://online.factsmgt.com/aid>. Families of students currently receiving grants are reminded that all grants are for one year only, and anyone seeking to renew a grant for the 2024-2025 school year must reapply. Deadline date for the completed application is April 26, 2024. Notification of grant awards will be made in June of 2024.

Another funding opportunity is also available due to the Invest in Kids Act legislation in Illinois. Students may be eligible for up to 100% of tuition and fees under a new program for tax credit scholarships (TCS). Details on how to apply and who qualifies are available on the Empower Illinois website at www.empowerillinois.org. Students who receive a TCS are ineligible to receive a Spalding award.
