



A Note From the Pastor



Dear St. Malachy Parishioners,

"They set out at once and returned to Jerusalem where they found gathered together the eleven and those with them... Then the two recounted what had taken place on the way and how He was made known to them in the breaking of the bread" (Luke 24:33,35). As we return to Ordinary Time, we return for one final week to the original theme verse(s) for this Year of Missionary Discipleship. As we return to these words, we can notice that the call of missionary discipleship begins when the Lord makes Himself known to us, which then leads us go

make Him more widely known to others.

This weekend, we can wonder at the fact that the Lord makes known to us His own inner life, as a Communion of Divine Persons. In revealing the Holy Trinity to us, He is making Himself known to us in a deeply intimate manner. In this month of Mary, it is worth noting that the first revelation of the Trinity was given to Mary, at the moment of the Annunciation. As one priest who taught us in seminary very vividly put it many years ago, it was as if God the Father lifted the veil for her and said, "Surprise! I have a Son!" Yet, the simplest description of the Holy Trinity might be found in the First Letter of Saint John: "God is Love."

How awesome that the God who is Love, made us in His image and likeness! We are made by Love for love to love. We were not made to live lonely, selfish or isolated lives. We were made for relationship, with God and with others. These words remind me of a brief summary I made years ago of the most basic life lesson that we have learned from our three most recent popes. See below.



I hope you can join us next week for our Corpus Christi Celebrations next weekend: Explanatory Mass (5 PM, Saturday), Outdoor Procession (after 8:15 AM Sunday Mass) and Outdoor Adoration (after 10:30 AM Mass until 4 PM). May we approach the bread of life ready to ENCOUNTER the Risen Christ, so that we may GROW in His grace and truth and GO share the Good News with the world.


