

Dear St. Malachy Parishioners,

Welcome to the Year of Eucharistic Spirituality! Let us begin by remembering our Saint Malachy

Revival Prayer: Lord Jesus Christ, You have made Yourself PRESENT to us in every age, through the Holy Eucharist. Help us to make You more widely KNOWN, that You may be greatly LOVED. Amen.

Last year, we began to turn our focus to the second part of the prayer, the call to make Him more widely known, in the Year of Missionary Discipleship. In this final year of the National Eucharistic Revival, we will focus on the last part of the prayer, which answers the question of *why* we must make Him more widely known: that He may be greatly loved. Thus, the vision of this final year is focused on being United in Love, with Him and with one another in Him. This might be described as a very basic fruit of the Holy Eucharist, which serves as a foundation for understanding and living a Eucharistic Spirituality.

In order to live this Eucharistic Spirituality of being united in love, the goal of this year is to get in touch with our deepest desire: the hunger and thirst for Christ that is fulfilled in that Holy Communion that so unites us to Him that we are broken and poured out with Him and in Him, as we are sent out on mission. Our hearts' desire, then, can be understood in three simple movements:

Come to Christ. Go with Christ. Remain in Christ.

As you may recall, in the latter weeks of the Easter Season, we were often brought back to this

call to remain in Christ. Our going out on mission is not a going forth from Christ, but going with Him, as He remains in us and we remain in Him. He gave us this promise when He first taught us about the Eucharist in the Bread of Life Discourse: "Whoever eats my Flesh and drinks my Blood remains in Me and I in him" (John 6:56). Yet, He also returned heavily to this theme of remaining in Him, that He may remain in us, when the Eucharist was finally instituted at the Last Supper. The extensive speeches and prayers of the Lord Jesus from that First Eucharist will be a fitting point of prayer and reflection for this year. And so, I commend to you and your personal prayer chapter 13-17 of the Gospel of John. For now, I will close this brief opening reflection of this Year of Eucharistic Spirituality with our new theme verse: "Remain in me, as I remain in you. Just as a branch cannot bear fruit on its own unless it remains on the vine. so neither can you unless you remain in me" (John 15:4).




