A Note From the Pastor



Dear St. Malachy Parishioners,

"Whoever does the will of God is my brother and sister and mother" (Mark 3). Our Lord is inviting us to follow the example of His mother Mary, who does the will of God. We see this both in her yes to the angel,

inviting Jesus to come and live within her, and in how she lived out her yes throughout her life. "Behold, I am the handmaid of the Lord. May it be done to me according to your word." May she help us, by her examples and intercession, to do the will of God in our lives. And yet, the simplest way in which she models doing the will of is by welcoming Jesus Christ to come and dwell within her, that she may carry Him into the world.

Is this not what we do when we receive Him in Holy Communion, albeit in a very different, but no less real, way?! We welcome Jesus Christ to come and dwell within us, so that we may carry Him into the world. Like Mary cherishing the presence of Christ dwelling within her, may this new Year of Eucharistic Spirituality, which we just began last week, become an opportunity for all of us to learn to abide within that deep union with Him. "Remain in me, as I remain in you. Just as a branch cannot bear fruit on its own unless it remains on the vine, so neither can you unless you remain in me" (John15:4).



**THANK YOU:** What a beautiful start we had to this third and final year of the National Eucharistic Revival last weekend! I am thankful to everyone who helped make the Explanatory Mass, the procession and outdoor adoration

go smoothly. Certainly our Liturgy Committee, choir and musicians helped with many preparations, as they always do. Also, our maintenance and janitorial staff helped with the setup of the Mahoney Shelter. Our altar servers, deacons and ushers also helped take on some extra duties, and with very little preparation. Finally, thank you also to everyone who participated! One count told us that 119 people were in the procession after the 8:15 Mass, which makes 120 with Jesus! I don't know how many people came to outdoor adoration, but there were a very good number coming and going throughout the afternoon and it was a beautiful, peaceful time of prayer. Mostly, thanks be to God for such a beautiful day for the gift of the Holy Eucharist!

**EXTENDED PRAYER:** Last weekend's homily closed with a sort of extended version of the Saint Malachy Revival Prayer. I invite us all to continue praying it: Lord, Jesus Christ, deep within us we find that hunger and thirst for You, that is fulfilled in that Holy Communion which so unites us to You that we are broken and poured out with You and in You, as we are sent out on mission. May this desire grow within us, that we may come to You, go with You and always remain in You. Lord, You have made Yourself present to us in every age through the Holy Eucharist. Help us to make You more widely known that You may be greatly loved. And grant, Lord, that we may be united in Love, with You and with one another in You. AMEN.

**NEW VESTMENT:** At the Explanatory Mass, I mentioned that we were using a new vestment. This beautiful vestment with profound symbolism was a gift of a group of donors within the parish, who took the initiative to replace our old gold vestment, which had been worn beyond usability. Its display of the Sacred Eucharistic Heart of Jesus (see front cover) is very fitting for last weekend's Corpus Christi celebrations, taking place at the beginning of the Month of the Sacred Heart (June). The vestment was first used at Easter, throughout the octave.
