## *A Note From the Pastor*



Dear St. Malachy Parishioners,

*"We aspire to please him, whether we are at home or away" (2 Cor 5:6-10).* I always enjoy when the words of the Scriptures from the Lectionary that we use for Mass apply in an ironically unintended manner to the given time of year. These words seem especially fitting for the summer, as so many people are planning around travel schedules to keep their faith the first priority in their lives. Maybe someone reading this is a visitor, who is traveling and is away from home. But, aspiring to please Him whether you are at home or away, you made a point to find a place to go to Mass. If that is you, we are so glad that you found us and could join us for worship this week! You are always welcome to join us, whenever your travels bring you to, through or near Geneseo. Maybe someone reading this is a parishioner traveling and away from home, attending Mass somewhere else this weekend. But, desiring to stay connected to your parish community, you took the time to read the online bulletin and/or weekly update. If that is you, we are so glad we could stay connected in this way. I always admire when I see parishioners who are "usuals" at one Mass attending another Mass time, because you had a change in your schedule and you made a point to still prioritize your attendance at Mass. 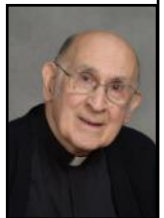

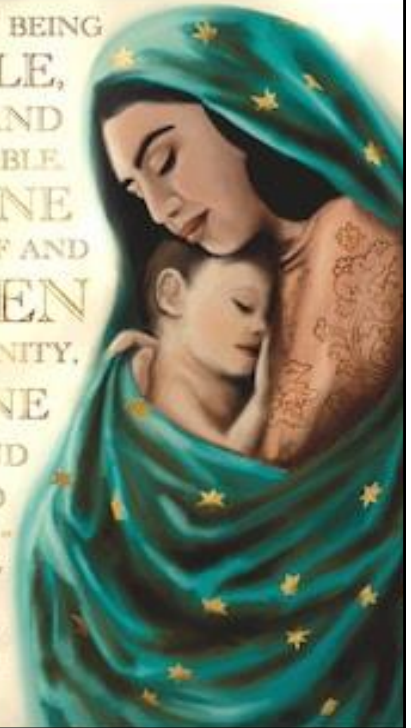


