"We aspire to please him, whether we are at home or away" (2 Cor 5:6-10). I always enjoy when the words of the Scriptures from the Lectionary that we

use for Mass apply in an ironically unintended manner to the given time of year. Maybe someone reading this is a visitor, who is traveling and is away from home. But, aspiring to please Him whether you are at home or away, you made a point to find a place to go to Mass. 


