Dear St. Malachy Parishioners,

"Do not be afraid; just have faith." (Mark 5). These words of Our Lord from this weekend's Gospel speak confidence and peace into our hearts in a wide variety of situations. Often facing much uncertainty in

our lives, we can find ourselves in need of receiving this gift. When we hear, "Do not be afraid," we might think, "if only it were that easy!" But, Our Lord tells us today the secret to being free from fear: just have faith. The faith to which He's calling us is a matter of trusting Him. Whatever uncertainty we might be facing, we are not stepping blindly out into the void. We are stepping out with Him, one step at a time, trusting in the One who is leading us. May you and I begin to walk this path with greater determination and hope today. Let us come to Christ, go with Christ and remain in Christ. "Remain in me, as I remain in you. Just as a branch cannot bear fruit on its own unless it remains on the vine, so neither can you unless you remain in me" (John 15:4).

YOUTH DISCIPLESHIP DISCERNMENT: It has always been my strong conviction that offering the best possible opportunities for our youth to grow as disciples of Jesus Christ in the heart of His Church is one of the most important tasks in parish life! It has been a joy to grow with many of our young people and the adults who led them over the past almost-four years and I am grateful to all who have already served in this capacity . If you have seen recent announcements, you know that we are in a moment of transition in our youth programs, both youth ministry and religious ed. I want to communicate that I view this as a time of discernment, in which we step out in faith, one step at a time, allowing the Lord to lead us along the paths of His Will. We can take this approach because we trust that this is His work, not ours and He is in control. I share this for two reasons. First of all, I want to invite everyone to be fervent, but peaceful in praver, as you join me in entrusting this all to the Lord. Second, I want to communicate that I welcome your input. If you have thoughts, questions and ideas about the future of these opportunities, even if you're not sure how they might fit into what I have already posted

in our bulletin, please don't hesitate to send me an email or ask for a meeting.

EUCHARISTIC CONGRESS PRE-GATHERING: In a few weeks (July 17-21), a handful of individuals and families from our parish will be attending the National Eucharistic Congress in Indianapolis, the climactic event of the National Eucharistic Revival. Personally, I will be attending the last two days, as the conclusion of my vacation. Especially since we are traveling in separate groups, we will have a simple gathering for all who are attending beforehand, in order to familiarize ourselves with who is going from the parish and to exchange contact information, in hopes to be able to connect as a parish at least once at the Congress. 
