Letter from Father Simon



Coping with rejection

Our readings this Sunday give us stories of people who experienced rejection. Rejection is a dark side of love, a negative response to an overwhelming love, too much love. The most confusing face of love is rejection.

The Spirit of God took hold of Ezekiel, and he became a prophet to speak to a rebellious house. But God warned Ezekiel, "If they rejected me, they would reject my messenger. So, don't take it too personally." (Ezekiel 2:2-5) Paul welcomed a part of himself, his weakness, with a self-talk, "When I feel weak for the sake of Christ, I am strong." (2 Corinthians 12:7-10) Jesus returned home. He tried His new prophetic ministry at home, but His town people took offense at Him because they knew His ancestors. Jesus was amazed at their attitudes towards Him: but He knew it well. A champion has no special honor in his own house. (Mark 6:1-6) Jesus' response to rejection is vital. Many people are rejected by those they love. If someone rejects me, there are other people who need me. I focus on those who don't run away from me. I will not stop loving. Rejection is an opportunity to welcome the love of those who cherish my services and presence. I don't take rejection too personally. People appreciate things differently. I am okay.

News from Caribou, Maine.

I am originally from Benin, but am currently serving as parochial vicar in Caribou, ME. I arrived in Caribou on March 30, 2022. There were piles of snow, about three feet, on certain unplowed surfaces. I still remember my silent wondering about the cold, my many thoughts, and my fears. "How do people survive here? Cold weather, but a warm welcome with a genuine smile." The little town "Caribou" meaning "snow shoveler", was named on February 8, 1877, after the large reindeer once popular at the time. The name "Caribou" suggests that the animal was the staple of the people, and its French

origin may be seen as a reason why some people use French words and prayers. For example, people say "Comment ça va?" (How are you?), "Notre Père" (Our Father), "Je vous salue Marie" (Hail Mary), "Acte de contrition" (Act of Contrition), and so on. Someone said to me, "I feel different when I say it in French." It is a good neighborhood where you meet someone for the first time, and you chat like old friends. Everyone knows everyone else and little changes are noticeable to all: the light that goes on at odd hours, the sparks from a chimney, the mailbox that is full, the unplowed snow at the main entrance, and a sudden absence makes neighbors worried. Everybody speaks of the olden days of potato harvesters, snowmobiling in winter, the coldest temperatures, and sometimes hunting and fishing. The people miss the Loring Air Force Base of the 1950s.

The faith of the Catholic community of Caribou is expressed through the clustered Parish of the Precious Blood, where I serve, which comprises ten worship sites of which five were parishes. The faith of the aging members is strengthened by the ministry of their pastoral agents through the celebration of sacraments at various worship sites, nursing homes, communion to the homebound, and Viaticum. The parish celebrates fewer baptisms and weddings, but many funerals. The declining population with the fixed income of its aging members remains a challenge for the life of the church. But God takes care of His mission. Not as man sees does God see. Their strong devotion to St. Anne, praying the rosary, retreats, various faith sharing groups. healing Mass, and helping the suffering and needy through "Always Hope" (an organization of the parish for giving help to the needy) shows the unity of the Christian faithful. I invite you to plan your own visit to Caribou.
