A Note From the Pastor



Dear St. Malachy Parishioners,

“Jesus... began to send them out two by two” (Mark 6). When I read this simple account of how Our Lord sent His first priests out on mission, it makes me especially grateful to have had a second priest with me these past few weeks. Thanks to our ongoing partnership with SMA (The Society of African Missions), I have been pleased to welcome a second priest into the parish for a few weeks in the summer for the third year now. It is a joy to have someone to work alongside, having a sense of being sent out two by two, even if only for a few weeks. Last weekend, you all had the chance to hear from Father Simon, in both the bulletin and the homily and I am grateful that our children also had a chance to learn from him and get to know him at Totus Tuus. He has been a very good influence on me, especially as we have watched *The Chosen* together, leading to many involved discussions about the Sacred Scriptures, in which I learn a great deal. I am now happy to leave the parish in his capable hands for a week, while I travel on a road trip, visiting friends and family and seeing places of personal interest to me. My vacation will end next Saturday, July 20th at the National Eucharistic Congress, in Indianapolis, IN, where I look forward to enjoying the conclusion of the conference along with some of our parishioners and thousands of others from around the nation. May this climactic moment of the National Eucharistic Revival be an experience that bears fruit for the whole universal church, including our own parish family. Let us come to Christ, go with Christ and remain in Christ. *“Remain in me, as I remain in you. Just as a branch cannot bear fruit on its own unless it remains on the vine, so neither can you unless you remain in me”* (John 15:4).

INTERIM ASSISTANT FOR FAITH FORMATION: As you probably know, we are in a moment of transition with our youth programs. I am happy to share that we have multiple applicants for the various positions we have posted regarding the discipleship of our youth. And there is still time, if there are others interested in being considered. A hiring committee has been assembled to discern all possibilities and we hope to reach a final decision on all positions before the end of August, after interviewing applicants. In the meantime, **Shannon Carroll** has agreed to serve as an Interim Administrative Assistant for Faith Formation. She will be the initial point of contact for questions about CCD and youth ministry for the time being and she will be working with me behind the scenes to help keep things moving forward and to help ensure a smooth transition.

SURVEY RESPONSE UPDATE: This summer, I have had the chance to meet with a subcommittee from Parish Council to discuss the feedback that we have received from the stained glass window survey offered in March, as well as related discussions, in order to discuss how we can improve transparency, communication and parishioner engagement particularly surrounding my consultative process in decision making. It is my confident hope that you will continue to see the fruits of this ongoing discussion. While the survey results did show a variety of thoughts, concerns and perspectives, they did not show consistent or widespread interest in a chance to discuss the matter in a group setting (5 of the 18 respondents expressed interest). However, we did reach out to individuals who chose to turn in surveys with a name to offer a chance for a follow-up meeting. I am grateful for the opportunity to sit down with a number of parishioners in order to hear and better understand their thoughts and concerns, as well as answer questions. If anyone else is interested in a chance to sit down, whether or not you filled out a


survey, I want to invite you to reach out to me, because I value all of our parishioners and benefit from hearing various perspectives.

SANCTUARY FLOORING: If you have followed updates that Deacon Robert has offered, you know that we have explored options for updating the sanctuary flooring in the church (keep in mind that the term 'sanctuary' in the Catholic Church refers to the area up the steps, around the altar, where the ministers are seated, not where the congregation is seated, which is called the nave). This project is prompted by the fact that some parts of the flooring are in bad shape and will soon need to be replaced. When the appropriate time to replace it arrives, this will be an opportunity to show greater reverence to the Eucharist, by surrounding the altar with smooth flooring, rather than carpet, making proper purification possible, especially if a Host is dropped. Since any change to our Sunday worship space impacts the whole congregation, I want to use this as a kind of trial of a process that involves more of the type of collaboration for which I have heard a desire from some of our parishioners. This weekend, I am sharing with you a sketch of the process that we plan to follow and invite your feedback through a questionnaire that is available in the narthex, along with a more detailed sketch of the process, both of which will be sent out by Flocknote on Monday. We ask for a return of all questionnaires by August 11. The process relies especially upon parishioner input, as well as the guidance of the Liturgy Committee, the Finance Council and the Building and Grounds Committee. Individuals from these committees, as well as a few other parishioners offered input that helped draft the process I am presenting now. These standing committees will offer their guidance to a subcommittee formed to focus on the project itself. This subcommittee will directly advise the Pastor, who will make the final decision, guided by prayer and the input received through this process. The process

consists of three phases: Discernment, Design and Implementation. The basic information gathering and initial discussions that have happened and are now still happening might be called a "pre-discernment" phase.

1. **The Discernment Phase** will consist of evaluating parishioner input and guidance from the Finance Council, Building and Grounds Committee and Liturgy Committee to determine whether or not to move forward with the project at this time.
2. If a positive recommendation results from the first phase, the Design Phase will consist of determining a specific design for the new flooring. If a negative recommendation results from the first phase, the second phase will focus only on the baptistery and entrance to the nave, in order to address the crumbling that already exists.
3. The Implementation Phase will consist of executing the plan determined in the second phase.

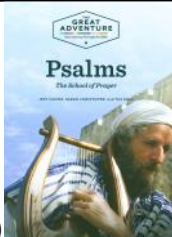
