

Dear St. Malachy Parishioners,

"Do not work for food that perishes. but for the food that endures for eternal life, which the Son of Man will give you." (John 6). I hope these words of this weekend's Gospel find you

focused, not on working frantically for the things of this world, but on gathering a spiritual offering to bring to the altar, where the Lord gives you "the food that endures for eternal life." Please pray that I might do the same, as I work hard to prepare for the summer to transition into fall. We have much that we are looking forward to and preparing for in the new school year soon to dawn upon us. Finally, of course, it is not only the youth grateful that our next Adult Bible Study will soon begin. In the week of August 20, we will begin Psalms: The School of Prayer, which is part of the Great Adventure Bible study series. I hope you can join us. This study will end just before our upcoming Parish Mission (November 3-5). Praise God for so many opportunities to seek to remain in Him and to grow closer to Him! May we grow ever more united in Love with Him and with one another in Him. "Remain in me, as I remain in you. Just as a branch cannot bear fruit on its own unless it remains on the vine, so neither can you unless you remain in me" (John 15:4).


