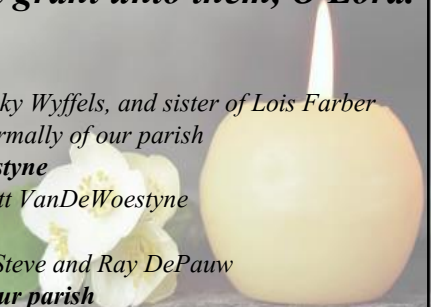

Dear St. Malachy Parishioners,

“Just as the living Father sent me and I have life because of the Father, so also the one who feeds on me will have life because of me.” (John 6). Jesus understood His mission in being sent by

In Memory of Father Pakula, St. Malachy Parish will have a monthly theme to collect items for the Geneseo-Atkinson Food Pantry.

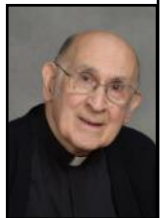

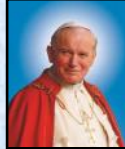
