

# A Letter from the Pastor



Dear St. Malachy Parishioners,

"He has done all things well." (Mark 7). We read these words in our Gospel today, in response to yet another miracle of Our Lord. How many miracles has He worked for us through the years?! As we

look back on the years that have gone by, let us ask the Holy Spirit to help us recognize His Presence and be moved to gratitude, wonder and praise. Then, we can look forward to the future with renewed hope. May we indeed be people of such hope, and grow to be evermore united in love with the Lord and with one another in Him. "Remain in me, as I remain in you. Just as a branch cannot bear fruit on its own unless it remains on the vine, so neither can you unless you remain in me" (John 15:4).

ANNUAL DIOCESAN APPEAL: The time has come already to kick-off another Annual Diocesan Appeal (ADA). This is a great moment for us to remember that we are a part of a larger church and to do our part to help support various ministries provided by our diocese. The funds raised through the ADA help to provide important services around the diocese, some of which come back to directly benefit us here at Saint Malachy. This year, I want to devote space in this bulletin letter to discussing how the ADA relates to and impacts parish finances. Every year, the diocese calculates a goal for us based on our parish ordinary income. This goal is what we will pay to the diocese. Any excess that is raised will be paid back to the parish and any shortfall will need to be paid from parish funds. In the years that we have raised more than our goal, the money paid back to us went into an account called ADA Reserve, which is then used when we need to pay a shortfall. 2022 was the first year since 2017 that we did not reach or exceed our goal. Thanks to the ADA Reserve account, we were able to pay this with little impact on our parish finances, as the account still remained in the positive after the payment. Thus, your

past contributions to the ADA helped put us in a better position today.

It is worth addressing two questions about the experience of not reaching our goal in 2022: How did that happen? And how did we respond? There are two basic reasons we did not reach the goal in 2022. First, actual Income (the amount we raised) decrease. I am not speculating on why it decreased, but simply noting the fact. Second, our goal was higher than the year before. Why was it higher than the year before? First, the diocese did apply the highest possible increase (15%). And secondly, our parish ordinary income from the previous year had increased, which it has every year since. This is an ever-present dynamic with the ADA: increases in parish income can lead to a higher goal for the ADA, which will be harder to reach. Next, how did we respond to the shortfall in 2022? We began preparing for the possibility of paying another shortfall in 2023 (which was the ADA we have just concluded). There had been a parish custom which precedes my time as pastor to transfer loose change from the weekly collection to one of three accounts. In the years when the parish was exceeding its goal, the ADA Reserve account was the third on the list, meaning that it did not receive very much of that loose change. Since we had begun to experience a shortfall, we moved it to the front of the list, especially since the other two accounts, Social Justice and Paraclete, were then and still remain in good shape, as people pay into them, whereas no one pays into ADA Reserve. This resulted in an increase of \$16,492 for that account, for a total balance of over \$34,439. Meanwhile, our shortfall for 2023 is \$16,444, as of July (we are still awaiting final numbers for August). So, thanks to this ADA Reserve account, even though we again did not reach our goal, we will again be able to pay the shortfall with little impact on our parish finances, with a slightly higher positive balance remaining in the account for future years.

One other piece of good news is that we did have a slight increase in our actual ADA Income from the previous year. Thank you for that! Another piece of good

financials to reach or exceed this goal. Anything you can do to help us accomplish this would be greatly appreciated.


PARISH BUDGET AND FINANCES: Earlier this summer. I shared with you that the Parish Budget for this fiscal year would be approved after the July Finance Council meeting. This extra consultation with the council, which continued after the meeting due to lower meeting attendance, was very helpful and important to me and was worth the additional time. Additionally, the process continued as we finalized the hiring of both church and school staff. Nonetheless, the budget is now approved. We are projecting \$1.4 million for both income and expenses. Since our most valuable asset is our people, the most significant increases in expenses are salary increases. A few other increases include additional funds for our upcoming parish mission and for youth ministry. With the help of our Finance Council, we decreased expenses where we could, especially when less than was budgeted had been previously spent. Regarding what we have budgeted for annual Sunday Collections, you will notice that we decreased our goal, in light of the shortfall we experienced this past year. Last year, we budgeted \$780,000 and only collected \$747,000. This year, we are budgeting for \$766,000, in order to accommodate the increases mentioned above, which are genuinely needed. So, to be direct, while we tried to accommodate for our recent lower collections, we do need to collect more in our Sunday collection than we did this past year. Please know that I greatly appreciate all of the sacrifices that you all make, in order to make possible your offerings of time, talent and treasure in support of the mission of making disciples here in Geneseo!

Since I have mentioned last year's shortfall in our budget for the annual income for Sunday Collections, please allow me to offer a few comments that will hopefully provide a more complete picture of our

news is that we have also had a slight reduction in our financial situation at the present moment. We are goal, which will be \$102,404. Hopefully, from this working to update the method of our weekly financial information it is clear that it will benefit our own parish reporting in the bulletin, as it has come to our attention that our current method only gives people a very incomplete picture, as it reports on only certain aspects of income and nothing regarding expenses. As a result, we have heard some concerns about our finances that don't match the impressions of our Finance Council and Parish Staff. By the end of this month, you can look forward to a change in that weekly reporting, offering a clearer picture of where we stand with regard to both income and expenses, as well as a more detailed report on the end of the year financials. Part of what you will see in that reporting is that, last year, our income exceeded our expenses by \$1,509. Furthermore, we preserved our assets (savings and investment accounts) at a combined balance of over \$3 million, which is a modest increase from the previous year. We have a great deal for which we can be thankful and hopeful. Still, we must and will continue to remain diligent and focused, striving to make the most prudent decisions we can make. For this reason, I am extremely grateful for the advice and guidance of our Finance Council and our Business Manager, Jennifer Higgins. And lastly, I am grateful to you all for your generosity and spirit of stewardship. And on that note, I also want to express my gratitude to my predecessor, Father Michael Pakula, who worked so hard to promote this spirit of stewardship.
