A Letter from the Pastor



Dear St. Malachy Parishioners,

“Draw your strength from the Lord and from his mighty power. Put on the armor of God so that you may be able to stand firm... and, having done everything, to hold your ground.” (Ephesians 6). These

words from our First Reading capture how I believe someone coming forth from our Parish Mission can face the trials of life in this coming week. I am so thankful that over three hundred people have had the chance to be a part of this beautiful encounter with the Lord and with one another. May we go forth from this experience fully armored for the battle. How is this possible? The strength is not our own. It comes from the Lord! These days of mission have been all about reconnecting with the One who is our strength. May we go forth with Him to carry His Good News to hearts still seeking Him in our own lives.

As I am writing this, we still have one more night to go. But, one theme that has stood out to me is the presence of the Lord in our lives, even when we feel most distant from Him. He is with us and *wants to be close to us* all the days of our lives. May we welcome His presence in our lives every day.

In this Year of Eucharistic Spirituality, one of the objects of reflection has been the words of our Lord at the Last Supper (John 13-17). One of the themes frequently repeated is the call to ***Remain in Him***. If you're anything like me, we can wander away pretty easily. When we realize that we have done so, the Enemy wants us to believe that all hope is lost, as he keeps tearing away at our armor. But, the Lord is always one prayer away. He never takes His eyes off of us. Further, He offers us the gift of the Sacrament of Reconciliation, of which disciples are encouraged to make frequent use throughout the year (once a month

is a good goal). Since the Lord never abandons or forgets us, let us remember Him today and rise in loving union with Him. May we be united in love with the Lord and with one another in Him. *“Remain in me, as I remain in you. Just as a branch cannot bear fruit on its own unless it remains on the vine, so neither can you unless you remain in me”* (John 15:4).

THANK YOU: Again, I want to thank all who have worked so hard to serve in many ways. From preparing funeral luncheons or singing in the choir, to all of the work involved with the mission to the hard work of our Parents Club for the Lasagna Take n' Bake, so many of you have been working very hard in the past few weeks. Please know of my gratitude for you all!

JOIN ME IN IRELAND: Last week, while preaching about the life and example of Saint Malachy, I mentioned my upcoming pilgrimage to Ireland and Northern Ireland this summer. Information has been in this bulletin for a few weeks now. I do want to call your attention to the fact that there was a slight shift in the dates from the moment that we first announced. The trip will be July 23-31. The highlight will be Knock, the site of Our Lady's appearance in 1879. But, of course, we will also spend the trip walking in the footsteps of Saint Patrick, Saint Malachy and various other holy men and women from the Isle of Saints and Scholars. I really hope you can join us.

In Memory of Father Pakula, St. Malachy Parish will have a monthly theme to collect items for the Geneseo-Atkinson Food Pantry.

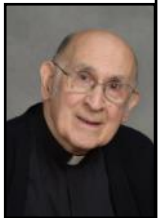
The theme for **November** is:

Flooring Project Status Update:

The Flooring Subcommittee has concluded the Discernment Phase. With the recommendation of the Building and Grounds Committee, a decision has been reached to postpone the upgrades to the *sanctuary* flooring and focus our current project on repairing the broken tile. We had a very productive conversation about assessing the root cause of the crumbling. Once the problem has been addressed, we plan to put down carpet that will cover the entrance to the nave, including the part of the tile that is now cracked. We hope to return to the project of upgrading the flooring in both the sanctuary and the nave in 3-5 years, as funds and other circumstances allow.
