In Memory of Father Pakula, St. Malachy Parish will have a monthly theme to collect items for the Geneseo-Atkinson Food Pantry.

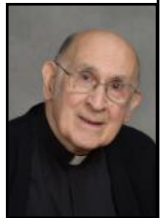

### Flooring Project Status Update:

The Flooring Subcommittee is in the process of working with professionals to address the cause of the cracked tile in the baptistery and then execute a plan to replace the damaged area. We hope to return to the project of upgrading the flooring in both the sanctuary and the nave in 3-5 years, as funds and other circumstances allow.

### Finance Council Report

Finance Council meeting covering period July 1 - September 30:

- 1. Balance Sheet** - Ended September with assets at \$3.2M split equally between Cash and Investments (Diocesan managed).
- 2. Income Statement** - Q1 generated a \$60K net income primarily from school tuition paid "in-full" versus monthly installments. For the YTD budget, Total Income and Total Expense were 115% and 98%, respectively.
- 3. Long-Term Planning** - The council intends to develop a one-page summary depicting a plan for how larger repairs and replacements to the church and school could be funded through its combined assets (cash and investments) or capital campaign, when necessary. We expect to work in conjunction with the Buildings & Ground Committee and the Facilities Manager to identify and prioritize these larger capital projects.
