A Letter from the Pastor

Dear St. Malachy Parishioners,



"Peace I leave with you: my peace I give to you. Not as the world gives do I give it to vou. Do not let vour hearts be troubled or afraid" (John 14:27). Last week, introduced this verse as our theme verse

for this Advent. The Lord is the source of our peace. He made this promise of peace at the Last Supper, which has been the source of our theme verses for this third John (Chapters 13-17), we have an elaborate account of much that He did, taught and prayed at the Last Supper, beyond the basic story of instituting the Eucharist and the priesthood, recounted in the other gospels. We will have a chance to feature different elements of this account of the First Mass, throughout the various seasons of the remainder of this Year of Eucharistic Spirituality.

As we ask for the peace that the Lord wants to give us, our hearts and minds turn to Our Lady, who is a model of having one's heart fully open to receive all that the Lord wants to give us. In particular, we wonder at the unique gift which made her so perfectly open: the Immaculate Conception. As we celebrate this mystery with the Holy Day this week, it is a fitting time to remember that this has not only been taught by the church, infallibly declared (1854) and indicated in Scripture (Luke 1:28), but it also has been confirmed by Our Lady herself to a young girl in 19th Century France.

In Lourdes, France young Bernadette was given a great gift. After getting separated from her friends while collecting firewood, she had a vision of a beautiful lady, dressed in blue and white. Although she did not immediately know for certain that it was Mary, the lady would later identify herself by saying, "I am the Immaculate Conception." She instructed Bernadette to pray the rosary and they prayed it together. This was the first of many such visions and word began to spread.

Some were inspired by her, while others thought she was not well. People began to observe her during her daily visits to the grotto, where Our Lady appeared to her. Many bystanders were present to see a very strange thing that happened one day. She began digging in the ground like an animal. Now more than ever, people were concerned about her mental state. Nonetheless, she dug until she found a little trickle and began to scrape the ground, cupping her hand to raise what little water she could find to her mouth. The Ladv had told her to drink from the stream, even though no stream to speak of was yet found. The next day, that and final year of the Eucharistic Revival. 
