

A Letter from the Pastor



Dear St. Malachy Parishioners,

"A great sign appeared in the sky, a woman clothed with the sun, with the moon under her feet, and on her head a crown of twelve stars" (Revelation 12).

These words appeared in our First Reading earlier this week, as we celebrated the Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe. While this reading is common for various feasts of Mary, it is especially fitting in this case, as the description of how she appeared to John in Revelation very closely resembles how she appeared to Juan Diego. While the image of Our Lady of Guadalupe is not crowded with the stars, she is cloaked with them, as well as appearing "clothed with the sun, with the moon under her feet," But this image is not simply a painting, mosaic or any other natural form of religious art. Scientists have studied it and cannot find a natural explanation, because the image itself is truly miraculous.

"¿No estoy yo aquí, que soy tu madre?" (Am I not here, I who am your Mother?) This was the question that she asked Juan Diego on her fourth appearance to him, after he had tried to avoid her. She had appeared three separate times to ask him to request of the local bishop that a church be built there in her honor. The bishop had demanded a miraculous sign as evidence of the authenticity of the supposed appearances that Juan Diego was reporting. She had promised to provide one the next day. However, that next day, Juan Diego's uncle fell gravely ill. Rather than going to see Our Lady, he had taken a different route to go and pursue a priest to visit his uncle. She met him along that alternate route and she asked that famous question, that has long been associated with

this beautiful apparition, which brought revival to the land of Mexico. She was beckoning him to see that by his lack of trust that God would care for his uncle if he was faithful to his promise to her, he was failing to understand her maternal love for him. Then, she provided the miracle that she promised, arranging roses in his tilma - Castilian roses which were already miraculous, as they were neither in season nor native to Mexico. When Juan Diego opened his tilma to reveal the roses, the miraculous image of Our Lady of Guadalupe was seen printed there. Pilgrims continue to travel to Mexico to this day to see and honor this image.

May Our Lady of Guadalupe intercede for us, that our hearts may be open to receive the grace promised to us by Our Lord at the Last Supper: "Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you. Not as the world gives do I give it to you. Do not let your hearts be troubled or afraid" (John 14:27).

MARIAN CONSECRATION: At the end of Mass. last weekend. I extended an invitation to consider joining me in making a total consecration to Jesus through Mary (or "Marian consecration"). This is a beautiful experience that involves spending 33 days preparing your heart to consecrate your life totally to Jesus through Mary. This practice has been widely promoted by many great saints, such as Louis de Montfort, Maximillian Kolbe, John Paul II and Mother Teresa. A number of great books have been written to guide people through the process, such as the fairly recent and highly accessible 33 Days to Morning Glory by Fr. Michael Gaitley (we have copies in the office, which can be claimed for a free will donation). And it can be adapted for all ages, so that it can be a beautiful experience for families to have together, as I have personally witnessed. We will begin the preparation on December 31, 2024 and conclude with

our consecration on the Feast of the Presentation, the Baptism of the Lord (January 12), Lena Kempher February 2, 2025. Please prayerfully consider joining (5th grade) will receive her First Communion at the us.


