

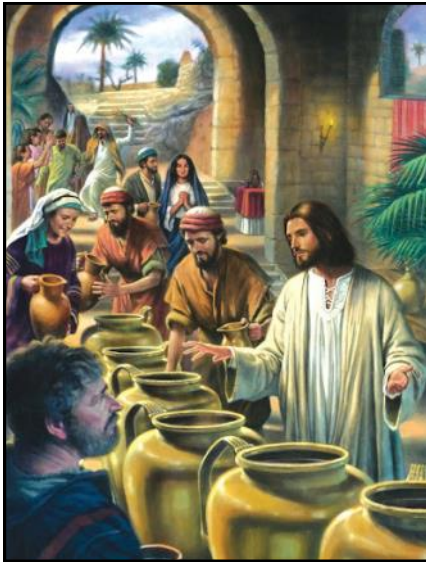

A Letter from the Pastor



Dear St. Malachy Parishioners,

"When a woman is in labor, she is in anguish because her hour has arrived; but when she has given birth to a child, she no longer remembers the pain because of her joy that a child has been born into the world." (John

16:21). These words served as our theme verse for the Christmas Season in this Year of Eucharistic Spirituality. Earlier this week, we officially returned to Ordinary Time. However, I want to keep using this verse for a while since, as I said at Christmas, I am encouraging us this year to set our sights on the traditional ending to the Christmas Season, the Feast of the Presentation (February 2). Recently, Dr. Mark Barber made the comment on Formed that, while this period between the Baptism of the Lord and the Presentation is no longer part of the Christmas Season, we might still consider the Presentation to be the "end of the Christmas cycle." So, if you haven't taken down the tree and lights yet, just go ahead and leave them up a little longer if you want. On the weekend of that great celebration, a total consecration to Jesus through Mary will take place after Masses, for which some of our parishioners are now preparing. And all are encouraged to pray the rosary in this first month of the new calendar year.

Another special connection of this weekend to the Christmas Season is that the Gospel appears to be a kind of extension of the celebration of Epiphany. You may recall that the Church has identified three events as epiphanies: the adoration of the magi, the baptism of the Lord and the miracle at the wedding feast of Cana. Every few years, it happens that those three stories are the Gospel reading for three consecutive Sundays. So, this weekend, we read the story of the Third Epiphany: the Wedding Feast at Cana. In this beautiful story of Our Lord's first miracle, we hear the final words of Our Lady recorded in Scripture: "Do whatever He tells you." John Paul II once pointed out that these words show us how Mary's heart is united in love with the Father, who will later introduce His Son to us with the same words He spoke at the baptism, with the addition of the command, "Listen to Him." When you put these words together, you have a beautifully simple and yet powerful statement echoing from the union of these two hearts: "This is My Beloved Son, with

whom I am well pleased. Listen to Him and do whatever He tells you." Let us heed these words, so that we may follow Mary's example and be united in love with the Heart of God.

STAINED GLASS WINDOW UPDATE: Today, I am happy to share with you that our stained glass window project is now *fully funded*, thanks to the generosity of over 180 donors within our parish. I am thankful to all who have supported this project, as well as for the fruitful dialogue that has surrounded it. We still anticipate installation later this spring or possibly summer.

RESPONSE TO QUESTIONS ABOUT MOVIES: A couple of movies about topics related to our faith are currently provoking a lot of questions. I have not seen either one, but have done some research to obtain guidance from trustworthy sources. This first one is the recent Netflix film simply titled *Mary*, about our Blessed Mother. The makers of this movie seemed to have good intentions of producing a positive and respectful portrayal. However, whatever other merits the film may have, it does not seem that they succeeded in portraying her in a true and faithful manner, especially since they pulled from a variety of sources, not all of which are reliable. So, I do not necessarily discourage you from watching it, but I would strongly caution that by no means should this film be considered an accurate source of information about Our Lady. The other movie is *Conclave*. This one did not begin with the same intention of presenting a positive or respectful portrayal of the church. Rather, the filmmakers did not seem to have a clear understanding of either the nature or the mission of the Church, but rather to view the Bride of Christ as strictly a human institution and to promote the idea that the appropriate response to the Catholic faith is one of doubt and suspicion. It is no surprise, then, that this film is also not a reliable source of any accurate information. I certainly would not recommend this film and if you do choose to watch it, it should be regarded as a fanciful exercise of fantasy and fiction.

Financial Assistance Available

Tuition assistance scholarship grants from the endowment fund established as a result of the Diocese of Peoria ROOTED IN FAITH Campaign and named in honor of Archbishop Spalding, the first Bishop of Peoria, will be available for the 2025-2026 school year for students enrolled in or intending to enroll in grades Kindergarten through 12 in any Catholic school located in the Diocese of Peoria whose families are active members of a Catholic parish in the diocese. All grants will be based on financial need objectively assessed.

Parents must apply online at: online.factsmgt.com/aid. Families of students currently receiving grants are reminded that all grants are for one year only, and anyone seeking to renew a grant for the 2025-2026 school year must reapply.

Deadline date for the completed application is **April 25, 2025**. Notification of grant awards will be made in June of 2025.

In Memory of Father Pakula, St. Malachy Parish will have a monthly theme to collect items for the Geneseo-Atkinson Food Pantry.

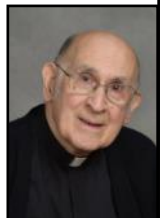
The theme for **January** is:

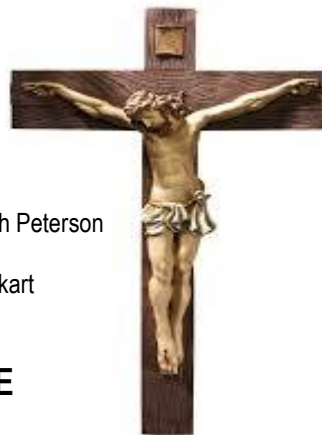
