A Letter from the Pastor



Dear St. Malachy Parishioners,

“When a woman is in labor, she is in anguish because her hour has arrived; but when she has given birth to a child, she no longer remembers the pain because of her joy that a child has been born into the world.” (John 16:21). We have kept this theme verse with us until this Feast of the Presentation, which Dr. Mark Barber considers “the end of the Christmas cycle.” Now, we come to a turning point, as we continue in Ordinary Time. Just over a month from now, we will enter the holy season of Lent. And so, these days might involve both some discernment of what Lenten disciplines the Lord may be inviting us to take up this year and also a life of genuine openness to what the Lord wants to do in our lives *today*, even in these “ordinary” days of our lives. The past month that we have spent with Mary can help us have that greater openness, since she is the Spouse of the Holy Spirit, who teaches us how to always be open to Him and led by Him.

Notice that we see this same witness in Simeon in our Gospel this weekend, as it mentions three times how he was led by the Holy Spirit. Let us ask Mary and all the saints to help us to always be open to the Holy Spirit, so that we may not only be led by Him, but even be united to Him, after the example of our Blessed Mother.

COLLEGE VISITS: Last Spring, I began a new custom of taking short times off (such as spring break) to visit some of our parishioners at their college campuses. Last year, I was able to host a Saint Malachy lunch and dinner at three different Illinois campuses. I am planning to continue this practice again this year, beginning with a lunch at

Western Illinois University on Monday, February 10. I have already connected with a few of our parishioners there, but if you know of anyone who may not be on my list and you are able to help connect them with us, please let me know so that they might be included. Additionally, I am planning another visit in March. Shannon Carroll had sent out a Flocknote asking for help building a contact list of our parishioners in college. She did receive a few responses, but we would love to have a more complete list, if you can help us fill in the blanks. Specifically, I am planning a visit to **Benedictine College in Atchison, Kansas**. And I could easily include a visit to the **University of Iowa** and/or **Iowa State University** on the way. Finally, I also hope to make a visit to **Bradley University** this spring. If you know of anyone at any of these campuses with whom you can help connect me, please let me know so that I can include them.

GOSPEL OF LUKE CHALLENGE: For the past two years, we have had hundreds of parishioners commit to doing their best to read one chapter a day of the gospel of the year during our gospel challenges. It has been a great way to grow together closer to the Lord by listening daily to His Holy Word. Our third annual gospel challenge will take place next month! On Saturday, March 1, we will begin the Gospel of Luke Challenge. Read Chapter One on the first day and finish with Chapter 24, just before the Feast of the Annunciation (March 25). Stay tuned for more information. But, mark your calendars, because I hope you can join us.

In Memory of Father Pakula, St. Malachy Parish will have a monthly theme to collect items for the Geneseo-Atkinson Food Pantry.

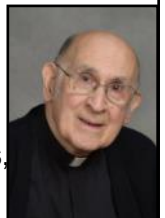
The theme for **February** is:

Tuition assistance scholarship grants from the endowment fund established as a result of the Diocese of Peoria ROOTED IN FAITH Campaign and named in honor of Archbishop Spalding, the first Bishop of Peoria, will be available for the 2025-2026 school year for students enrolled in or intending to enroll in grades Kindergarten through 12 in any Catholic school located in the Diocese of Peoria whose families are active members of a Catholic parish in the diocese. All grants will be based on financial need objectively assessed.

Information about the grants and application materials may be obtained from any Catholic elementary or secondary school in the Diocese of Peoria or on the Diocesan website www.cdop.org under **Catholic Schools** and then under **John Lancaster Spalding Scholarship**. Consult the detailed protocols and procedures and checklist at the bottom of the webpage for all requirements necessary to be eligible for an award.

Parents must apply online at: online.factsmgt.com/aid. Families of students currently receiving grants are reminded that all grants are for one year only, and anyone seeking to renew a grant for the 2025-2026 school year must reapply.

Deadline date for the completed application is **April 25, 2025**. Notification of grant awards will be made in June of 2025.

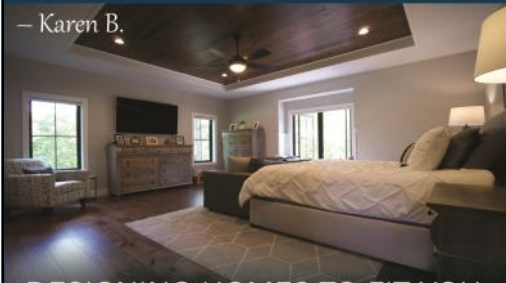
